Additional Information for visitors in 2018

Castle Eden Golf Club welcomes visiting parties and offers a variety of packages for your golf day.

Tee Reservations – 1st tee

Morning from 9:45 – 11:30; Afternoon from 13:30 – 15:00. Castle Eden's course layout returns to the clubhouse after 7 holes however after 9 there is a walk of less than 500 yards back to the clubhouse. Tees of the day for visitors are Yellow for gents and Red for ladies. To ensure all members and visitors enjoy the golf course our preferred choice is 3 balls. Mobile phones may be taken onto the course for emergency use.

Green Fees / Packages

We believe our all day green fee (Mon-Fri) remains competitive at £32 for a full day's golf with packages available for groups of 12 or more. If you require any additions to the package e.g. nearest the pin / longest drive our professional will arrange this on the day. We do ask for a deposit of £5 per player when confirming your booking with cheques payable to Castle Eden G C

Buggies & Trolleys

We are pleased to offer buggies for hire at £20 per round or £30 for all day during the 2019 season. Pull and Powakaddy trolleys are also available. Save on fuel by travelling in one car. Please indicate any requirements on the booking form which will be passed to the professional.

Golf Shop

Castle Eden GC Dress Code

Members and Guests are required to maintain a smart standard of dress when playing the golf course and in the confines of the Clubhouse.

ON THE GOLF COURSE

Golfers (caddies/supporters) are required to wear a collar -attached shirt (Males- tucked in at the waistband). Tailored shorts are permitted. Golf shoes must be worn.

(**NOT ALLOWED** – denim jeans, t-shirts, football/rugby/cricket or similar type sports shirts, track suits)

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

A smart standard of attire is required.

Males collar –attached shirts are to be tucked into the waistband.

Denim jeans may be worn (NOT if ripped, low hung, cut offs or soiled work wear). Clean, casual footwear is permitted.

(NOT ALLOWED – any form of golf footwear, flip flops/croc shoes, round necked t-shirts, beach or sports shorts, hats or caps, tracksuit tops or bottoms, shell suits, vests, rugby/cricket/football or similar type sports shirts)

Health & Safety Advice

In the event of an electrical storm, golfers are advised to suspend play immediately & take the appropriate action. (Rule 6-8a applies).

A claxon will sound if play is to be suspended
Golfers are advised not to tee off or continue play in fog / poor visibility when they cannot see the clear distance of their intended shot.

Golfers are advised that the course and its artificial surfaces may be slippery when damp or wet and must ensure they have appropriate footwear to meet the prevailing conditions.

Golfers should be aware of the steep slopes on the 6th hole if retrieving a golf ball from this area.

Golfers are advised that the Green's staff working on the course have priority at all times.

Golfers are reminded they have a duty of care for both themselves and all other course users.

If hiring a buggy please read the operating instructions prior to use

Golfers are advised to report all accidents immediately to the Honorary Secretary or a club official.
