2019 HAMPSHIRE GOLF INTER CLUB KNOCK OUT CHAMPIONSHIP

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Each Affiliated Club shall be eligible to enter. The entrance fee shall be agreed at a Committee Meeting.
2. ENTRANCE FEE - £70.00 per team.
3. Each team shall consist of SEVEN players who must be Full or Junior Members of the represented club and must have declared the Club their 'home' Club for handicap Purposes.
4. No player may represent more than one club in each annual competition. A player banned or suspended by his 'home' Club may not take part in this competition. A player banned or suspended from playing at any course or club entered in this competition may not play in any match played at the course or club.
5. Play will be by singles match play over 18 holes off handicap, with FULL HANDICAP DIFFERENCE being taken. Each game will continue by 'sudden death' until a result is obtained.
6. The maximum handicap of a player shall be 15, which must also be Active. Players with a handicap of greater than 15 may play but must play off a maximum of 15. It shall be the responsibility of the Team Captain to produce on the day a list of the names of his players showing their respective handicaps, current on the day of the match. Any team playing a player with an Inactive Handicap will be disqualified.
7. The Club at the top of each pair as drawn in the preliminary and first round matches shall have choice of venue. Thereafter until the semi-finals, when a new draw will be made, the winners of the matches in the appropriate section of the draw shall toss a coin for the choice of venue. However in Group 4, the fourth round match involving the Isle of Wight side shall be an away (2019) fixture for the Mainland side.
8. The 'home' Club must offer their opponents a minimum of three dates to play a match, at least three

dates must be on a Saturday or Sunday and if possible on different weekends. Clubs should arrange matches in the true spirit of Amateur Golf. Home Clubs are requested to give a courtesy practice round to their opponents. Courtesy rounds should be organised in advance, by prior arrangement with the 'home' club. Visiting Teams are asked to abide by the 'home' Club's Rules and Regulations at all times, both on and off the golf course.

Matches must be arranged in plenty of time to allow for any postponement due to course or weather conditions.

9. The Secretary or Captain of the winning match shall immediately report the result by phone (01962711532) or e-mail (secretary@hampshiregolf.co.uk) to the County Office at Hockley Golf Club. It remains the responsibility of both clubs in each match to ensure the match is played by the due date.
10. Matches will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the local Rules of the Club where the match is played.
11. In event of both Team Captains deciding that weather or course conditions are such that play is impossible, the match shall be re-arranged so that it can be completed by the final date of that round. Should the Captains disagree, the match must be played.
12. The winning Club shall hold for one year the Inter Club Knock-Out Championship Trophy. Prizes will be awarded to the winning club, the runners-up and both losing semi-finalists, who will play off for third and fourth places.
13. In Groups 1 and 4 the County will subsidise travel costs of Clubs travelling inter-island and to or from the Mainland. Also any Islands Clubs that reach Finals Day.
14. Hampshire Golf 'Conditions of Competition' apply. A copy can be viewed on the Hampshire Golf website.

PLEASE NOTE THAT AGREED TEE-OFF TIMES MUST BE ADHERED TOO, FAILURE MAY LEAD TO EITHER AN INDIVIDUAL MATCH OR TEAM DISQUALIFICATION.

Clubs should not insist on leaving a match until the last possible date because one or two of their best players are not available.

FAILURE TO COMPLETE MATCHES BY THE DUE DATE MAY LEAD TO BOTH TEAMS BEING DISQUALIFIED.

PLEASE NOTE

In addition to the competitive element, many clubs treat these matches as a friendly and social occasion and provide refreshments and a snack after the match. It does help to foster friendship between clubs but it is entirely up to each individual club. Players must be prepared to dress according to the rules of the host club, both on the course and in the Clubhouse.
