SAFETY ON THE GOLF COURSE

At the Council Meeting last night, Council discussed the concern regarding players who deliberately play tee shots down adjoining fairways which could increase the risk of injury to other players on the golf course – for example tee shots played from the 1st tee down the 18th fairway and tee shots played from the 9th tee down the 10th fairway.

Advice from our Health & Safety advisers has been taken. They share Council's concern that this is increasing the risk of accidents.

A decision was made that players **MUST** attempt to play the hole in the manner in which it was designed. If reports that players are choosing to ignore this important instruction continue to be received, individual disciplinary action against that player will be considered and the possibility of internal out of bounds introduced as a deterrent.
