## **Woodford Golf Club 3 Month Trial Membership (2019) Terms and Conditions**

The 3 Month Membership is available as a welcome and introduction to the Club.

**For a one off payment of £175** 'Trial Membership' entitles you to the following benefits:

- You will have 7 day playing membership (subject to tee availability) with unlimited access to the course outside of pre-booked competition times
- You may play in the Friday and Sunday Quota games - a friendly and accessible competitive format that takes into account playing ability (subject to an entry fee the same as a member pays)
- One free ½ hour lesson with a PGA qualified Professional
- One free Guest green fee for you to bring a friend to play with you.
- 20% Bar & Social Discount Card for the trial period.
- You can convert to a 7 day introduction member and **extend to a full year from your start date for £420 + £50 Bar card levy gaining 1<sup>st</sup> year Full membership** status, meaning the £175 is fully discountable from the normal 1<sup>st</sup> year rate of £595. + Bar card Levy (£50) can be used for coffee machine tokens or drinks from the bar.

### Conditions

- The membership can be taken up **once only** and has the duration of 3 months only from the time of joining. (Available to join up to the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019)
- You will not be eligible to play in Club competitions apart from the Friday and Sunday Quota games.
- You will not be able to play during a competition tee closure other than Quota games.
- You will not be able to obtain a CONGU handicap until you upgrade to an Intermediate 7 day membership.
- At the end of the 3 month period, you can transition to an Intermediate 7 day membership (see terms above).
- Conversion from 'Trial Membership' to membership categories other than Introduction will not be subject to the £175 discount.
- This offer is available for **new members only**. Previous members (with playing membership in the last 5 years) will not be allowed to re-join at this level, but could and would be welcomed back in one of the other categories.

Introduction Membership: Normal one year cost £595 + £50 Bar card levy.

Once you have transferred the Introduction Membership provides the following benefits:

- In **Year 1** for the equivalent of just **£49.60 a month or £5.72 a round** if you play twice a week – you can play our delightful woodland course as a 7-day member.

- there is the opportunity to enter in all Club competitions; to play in matches both home and away against other local golf clubs; to obtain an official handicap; to represent the Club in County competitions; to eat in our restaurant and to participate in the many and varied social activities arranged by the club
- In addition members can save appreciably on bar bills, by using the club-issued swipe card, which provides **around a 20% discount on normal beer, spirits and wine prices.**

**The Main Features of 7 day Introduction Membership are:**

- No entrance fee for membership.
- 7 day unrestricted membership for both men and women.
- Play in official Club competitions or socially just with your friends.
- Play in Club friendly's with other Clubs
- 20% Bar & Social Discount Card.
- Discount offers on booking club facilities for personal events
- Free County Card (18 years and over).with discounted green fee offers in Clubs across England
- Membership of 'England Golf'.
- Obtain an official CONGU handicap if you don't have one.

**Remember:**

You do not have to have a handicap to become a member. As part of becoming a member a handicap can be acquired.

You do not have to be an expert golfer to join Woodford Golf Club. We welcome players of all standards and have an excellent Club Professional who can teach you the game and if you are a beginner help you progress from the basics to become competent and confident at the game to maximise your enjoyment.

Except for competition entry (and you are not forced to enter competitions – it is entirely up to you), tee times are not bookable. As long as the tee is not closed – such as for a competition, a club match, or certain Ladies or Senior's fixtures, you can just turn up and play. At certain times of the day there are usually a number of members who gather for a friendly (yet often quietly competitive) round, over 9 or 18 holes.

On becoming a member, if you do not know any other members, we will arrange for you to play with at least one other member of a similar level of golf as a way of introducing you to both club and course (if you have not played it often or at all before).
