The good news is that we have the promises of like for like funding from two anonymous donors of £1350. In other words if you donate £50 the 'like for like' funding will make this into £100 pound for the club.





Greens Chairmans Report.







Since we last met we have hollow tined, scarified, top dressed and seeded the greens. The work had to be completed earlier than expected as the greens were showing signs of wear and tear. Apologies to the members for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Can I remind members to repair pitch marks on the greens even if it's not their own. I would also ask members not to take trollies around the collars / fringes of the greens to avoid damage. One last request, can members please rake the bunkers and replace the rakes in the metal holders provided, with the rake end in the bunker.

Our efforts over the coming weeks and months will focus on preparing the winter tees and repairing the damage to the grass tees. Winter tees and mats will be in play from the 22nd of October.

Finally, we have recently noticed tyre tracks on the course suggesting we have some unwelcome visitors. We've also notice some areas of damage on the first green that look like someone has been digging their heels into the green. There have also been instances of men riding mountain blkes across the greens. Can I ask all members to be vigilant and challenge strangers or anyone acting suspiciously on or around the course and to make myself and the greenkeeper aware of any such instances?

Once again a big thank you from myself and David to all the people who continue to offer their services and volunteer their time to help out on greens.




