Conditions:

1. The competition will be an 18 hole Mixed Strokeplay Competition**
2. The Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter start times. Rule 5.3a of the Rules of Golf shall apply to any competitor who is not present on the 1st tee at his/her appointed starting time, except that the note to the Rule shall apply.
3. No player may employ a caddie. Penalty: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.
4. In the event of ties the result shall be determined in accordance with the rules of England Golf.

ENTRIES

5. Entries shall be made only on the special Entry Form.
6. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status and shall sign the declaration to that effect contained in the Entry Form.
7. Entrants must be under the age of 18 at 00.00 hours on the 1st January 2019.
8. Entries shall only be accepted from Boys whose playing handicap do not exceed 18 & Girls 24.
9. THE EXACT HANDICAP CERTIFIED AT THE DATE OF ENTRY WILL BE USED FOR PURPOSES OF ENTRY ONLY.
10. Players shall enter through their Home Club. The Secretary of such club shall sign the declaration in the Entry Form that, to the best of his knowledge and belief, the entrant is eligible and conforms in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status.
11. Entries will be limited to 60 competitors. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries for the highest handicap competitors will be decided by ballot, using exact handicaps. The draw and starting time sheet will be sent to each competitor.

12. Signing the form signifies permission to take photographs of entrants.
13. Entrance fee of £15 together with a fully completed Entry Form, must be received by Pannal Golf Club not later than Friday 19 July 2019.
14. Cheques should be made payable to The Pannal Golf Club (Harrogate) Ltd, or a bank transfer may be made. Please call office for details.
15. The Entry Form must be fully completed and signed personally by the entrant. Entries will NOT be accepted by phone. Entrance Fees will not be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received before the closing date of entries, except for those entrants who may be balloted out and who do not subsequently compete. Entry Forms may be obtained through the website.
16. All entries will be subject to the approval of the Committee, which reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving reason for its decision. The Committee may also request the production of a Birth Certificate of any Competitor either before or during the competition.
17. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any Competitor making a false statement on their Entry Form.

Prizes:

18. Prizes will be awarded

For the best gross score [Wins trophy]
For second & third gross
Handicap Division Prizes
19. No competitor may be awarded more than one prize. If a competitor returns a score that would otherwise entitle him/her to be awarded more than one prize, he/she shall receive the prize first named in the list set out in the preceding paragraph.

20. Competitors are requested to register at the Clubhouse on the day of the Competition at least 30 minutes before their starting times.
