Code of Conduct for Parents and Junior Members of Waterford Golf Club

Junior Members and their Parents/Guardians are required to read the Codes of Conduct, sign the Declaration, and return it to Sheila Downey in the office, or the Pro Shop for the attention of the Junior Committee or the Director of Golf. The Rules shall be observed always within the grounds and environs of Waterford Golf Club and when competing at other Golf Clubs as a member of Waterford Golf Club and when away in other Clubs.

Code of Conduct

1. The club's rules and established practices shall be fully observed.
2. The goals of the game are to have fun improve your skills and to observe the rules of the game must be adhered to at all times.
3. Players must be correctly attired for golf - trousers, polo shirt, plain Jumper, and golf shoes (no tracksuit tops or bottoms).
4. Junior's should treat leaders, organisers, club officers and coaches with fairness and respect. Accept their advice with grace. Treat others as you would like to be treated yourself. That includes opponents as well as players. Bullying, unruly or disruptive behaviour and abusive language will not be tolerated.
5. The club facilities, this includes the course, practice ground should not be damaged intentionally.
6. Drug or substance abuse of any kind is not allowed, including under- age smoking or alcohol consumption.
7. The Junior Committee should be made aware of any underlying medical condition a junior member may have. Such information will be treated confidentially.

8. Juniors While in the Club House are not allowed to sit at the bar; NO running up and down the Stairs; No Shouting or the use of abusive language. Boys must not go in to the Ladies Locker room and Girls must not go in the men's Locker room.
9. Junior Boys and Girls must have their names down in the pro shop for all competitions and all Juniors Must report to the pro shop before play.
10. The Junior Committee looks after all the Junior competitions and they also supervise of all juniors on the course.
11. Parents or Guardian when Juniors are not playing in Competitions they must always phone the pro shop to book a time before coming down to avoid disappointment.
12. All Juniors must receive permission from the pro shop to go to the practice area.
13. Parents and Guardian please let the leader of the day know when Juniors are being collected after competitions.
14. The Locker rooms are not a waiting rooms and food shall not be consumed in the locker rooms

Any Parent / Guardian / Junior refusing to sign Code of Conduct cannot be a Member of the Junior Club at Waterford or Play in any Junior or Adult Club Competitions or inter club Competitions or play for the club.
