ENTRY CONDITIONS

- 1. Scratch Medal competition in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any Clandon Regis Local Rules as approved by R&A Rules Ltd. Approved distance measuring devices permitted.
- 2. Handicap Medal competition in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any Clandon Regis Local Rules as approved by R&A Rules Ltd. Approved distance measuring devices permitted.
- 3. Handicap limit of 12 or below at time of entry. Current CDH handicap number will be required.
- 4. Field limited to 72 players. Field will be selected by handicap if necessary.
- 5. Entrance Fees will be refunded to any entrant not selected.
- 6. The Clandon Regis Trophy will be engraved with the winners name and retained by the Club; the winner will be given a memento and the 1st prize.
- 7. Closing date for entries is Monday 29 July 2019 and draw times will be sent thereafter.
- 8. Competitors must be present at the prize-giving to qualify for any prize.

 Competitors may win any number of prizes providing the Rules of Amateur

 Status as defined by R&A Rules Ltd are not breached.
- 9. Ride on buggies only permitted on presentation of a current Medical Certificate signifying disability within the meaning of the Equality Act 2010.
- 10. In the event of a tie for the 36 hole Scratch Medal 1st prize, a sudden death medal play-off will be held over the 18th hole. If still a tie a repeated sudden death medal play-off on the 18th hole will be held until someone wins. All other ties will be decided by count-back over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 holes etc.
- 11. All matters relating to this competition will be settled by the Committee, whose decision will be final
- 12. Entry Fee will include morning coffee & bacon rolls, a sandwich lunch, supper and prize-giving.
- 13. The 'Hole In 1' prize is for a Par 3 hole only, and is only valid for the first competitor to make a hole in one.
