

Grange-over-Sands Golf Club Competitions and Trophies

Mixed Section (15-03-15)

ALAN WILSON CUPS men and ladies

Presented by Mr. Alan Wilson who was a member of the Club and was the proprietor of an antique shop in Grange next to the Post Office.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition played every Wednesday in June. STROKEPLAY handicap max 24 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The Alan Wilson cup is awarded for the best aggregate nett score over any two rounds with a smaller cup awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex. Only one entry fee for all rounds.

BIRLEY CUP men and ladies

Presented in 1939 to the old Grange Club by the family of Mr. Birley who lived in what is now the Methven Hotel. It was brought with other cups during the war and played for from 1948.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition. STROKEPLAY handicap max 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The BIRLEY CUP is awarded for the best nett score with a prize awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex.

CATERERS' CUP

This competition is open to all members including juniors with handicaps.

Format: TEXAS SCRAMBLE, shotgun start, teams drawn from the entry sheet.
Handicap: total of high, low and average of other two per team.

EASTER MIXED

Format: 4BBB STABLEFORD. Men white tees, ladies red tees and own card.
Handicaps: Men max. 28, Ladies max. 36, allowance $\frac{3}{4}$. Ladies play off Ladies Card. Prizes presented on the day.

JUBILEE CUP

Presented by the Club to mark the Club's Silver Jubilee.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED FOR LADIES. MIXED GREENSOME MEDAL.
Handicap limit 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The allowance is $\frac{3}{4}$ the combined handicaps. Cup presented on the day.

MASCORD TROPHY men and ladies

Presented by Mrs. M. Mascord in 1971 in memory of Mr. Reg. Mascord. The trophy was originally a number of old clubs but in 1995 it was decided to present a cup as the trophy.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition. STROKEPLAY handicap max 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The MASCORD TROPHY is awarded for the best nett score with a prize awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex.

MIXED INVITATION

Guests must hold their handicap at another club and partner a Grange member.

Format: BETTERBALL STABLEFORD. Handicap max: 24 for men, 36 for ladies and own card. Allowance $\frac{3}{4}$.

MIXED OPEN

Format: BETTERBALL STABLEFORD. Handicap max: 18 for men, 30 for ladies and own card. Full allowance.

MIXED SUMMER LEAGUE

Arrange own playing partner. The draw for fourballs will be after 1.00pm on the Thursday prior to the competition and the draw list will be posted on the mixed competition board and on the B.R.S.

Format: BETTER BALL STABLEFORD. Handicap limits Men 24, Ladies 36. Full allowance. Men play off white tees, Ladies off red and their own card. Points are awarded for the overall competition as follows; for the first six places each player of the pair gets 6,5,4,3,2 and 1 point. All competitors get 1 point for playing. All two's to be ringed by the marker. On the day, ties are settled by the normal countback rules, for the overall competition it will be based on the highest number of wins, seconds etc. Trophy each for the man and lady.

PECAN TROPHY

Donated by Mike and Christine Armer and so-called because it is made out of pecan-nut shells.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed 4 ball competition played on May Bank Holiday Monday. Aggregate STABLEFORD, team handicap max 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies and ladies play off their own card. Full handicaps.

PRO'S WINTER SERIES men and ladies

Played during the winter between November and March.

Format: VARIOUS. YELLOW TEES and handicap limit 28 for men, handicap limit 36 for ladies and own card. Winners qualify for 4BBB final.

THOMS CUP

Presented by Mr. A.O. Thoms President at the time after the war. It was to replace the Green Cups which never reappeared after the war.

Format: WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED FOR LADIES. MIXED FOURSOMES BOGEY. Handicap limit 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The allowance is ½ the combined handicaps. Men drive the first hole.
