Clubhouse & other facility Improvements:

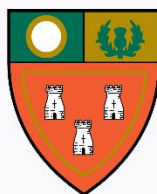
With the approval of Council, I have carried out a review and have instructed contractors to make a number of repairs and improvements around the Club. These include the replacement of old kitchen equipment, new gas interlock system, new CCTV system with improved coverage, strip lighting replacement to that of new LED lighting within the Bar, Kitchen, Cellar & Trolley store areas and a new alarm system for the green keeper sheds in advance of new green equipment arriving late March.

Course update:

Following on from the introduction of the Winter course, which was launched to provide golf on days where in the past the course would have been closed. Robert and team have re-evaluated the course set up. In order to enhance course playing conditions for our membership to enjoy, Robert has taken the decision to remove the wooden pallets from greenside bunkers bringing these hazards back into full play as from Monday 7th January. Only bunkers under renovation will be identified as non-play areas using wooden pallets after this date.



Mats will be introduced as from 3rd January to 28th February on both Courses and must be used on fairways at all times. It is not an option to move your ball to the semi-rough and not use a mat. A ball finishing in the rough must be played as it lies. Mats will be available for collection from the Professional shop and Clubhouse.
