



SENIORS INTER CLUB MATCH SELECTION GUIDELINES

1. For the first leg of each fixture in the year consideration will be given to players who were not selected, but agreed to act as a reserve, in the previous year's fixtures. To avoid an unfair advantage at the start of the season the final % CN to P Analysis positions in the previous year will be taken into consideration.

2. The Seniors Captain will play if his name is on the Calling Notice.
If not then the Seniors Vice Captain should be selected if he is available. The Seniors Captain (and in his absence the Seniors Vice Captain) will lead the team out in Game 1 accompanied by the Match Manager for the fixture.

3. Players are to be encouraged to participate in both the home and away leg of each fixture. If they are in the team and play the first leg then they will be given priority to play in the second leg. If there are any gaps then reserves from the first leg will be first choice replacements.

4. After the above criteria have been met then the % CN to P Analysis is to be followed working from the lowest ranked % players upwards through the listing.

5. The Seniors Captain, Vice-Captain and Committee have the right to vary the criteria on a fixture by fixture basis should circumstances and the need arise.
