COVID-19 'Return to the Clubhouse

PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE GOLF CLUB IF YOU ARE SUFFERING ANY COVID19 SYMPTOMS OR ARE REQUIRED TO SELF-ISOLATE FOR ANY OTHER REASON

Objectives:

- We will, unless the current restrictions change, reopen the Clubhouse on Sunday July 5th.
- This will be with the safety and wellbeing of members, visitors, and club staff as a priority.
- Initially only members and golfers will be permitted into the Clubhouse.
- All these arrangements have been influenced by the need to comply with government guidelines.

Entering the clubhouse by you and your playing partners will be deemed as acceptance of the conditions detailed in this policy document. If you do not agree with some/any of the terms, then please refrain from using the clubhouse.

Clubhouse Entry Marshall:

- A Marshall will allocate a table (or tables) to groups entering the clubhouse. Tables inside the clubhouse can only be occupied by members of 2 households. Tables outside can have up to 6 people from multiple households.
- The Marshall will be responsible for the safety of all persons entering the clubhouse. Please listen to his/her requirements & guidelines on your

visit. Please respect the requests by the Marshalls regardless of your own feelings.

IMPORTANT: Please note that initially the TV's will be turned OFF

Opening Times

Bar Hours

Monday – Tuesday 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Wednesday – Saturday 10:00 am to 9:00 pm Sunday 12:00 am to 6:00 pm

Catering Hours

Monday – Friday 10:00 am to 3:00 pm Saturday 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Sunday 12:00 am to 4:00 pm

Please Note:

These times will be strictly adhered to, the clubhouse will not be open before these times, but they can be amended at any time, depending on any changes in lockdown rules or usage of the services and will be at the discretion of the Clubhouse manager.

Clubhouse Set Up

Seating Areas

There will be a one-way system in the clubhouse which must be strictly adhered to, as seen in the video.

Seating areas will be clearly defined.

You will be allocated a table when you register, on arrival.

You must use your designated table.

Chairs/Tables must not be moved to enable groups to sit together.

You must always adhere to the social distancing policy.

In the Clubhouse

When entering the clubhouse please use the hand sanitiser provided.

Sit at your allocated table – there will be no standing at the bar or elsewhere.

Only one person from each group should go to the bar.

Service will be via a single window at the bar, drinks and food can only be ordered and paid for in this area.

After your drinks have been prepared, you can pick them up from the opposite end of the bar.

It is preferred that payments are made by card. Either contactless payments using a debit card or by using your golf club bar card, however cash will be accepted.

Catering Service

A limited food service will be offered during the times shown.

The food menu will be clearly displayed upon entering the clubhouse.

Food ordering and payment will be at the bar.

General

We remind everyone to stay more than 1 metre apart whenever you are in the clubhouse.

Toilets will be one person in and one person out, it is mandatory to wash your hands, and to ensure that any surfaces you touch are wiped down with the sanitising wipes provided.

Time Slots

Members, Golfers and subsequently visitors are reminded that social distancing is as important after a round as it is during the round, so wherever you are on the premises remember to keep apart.

Gatherings in and around the clubhouse area are not permitted.

In order that all members have availability to use the clubhouse, there will initially be a time limit within the clubhouse after your round, of two hours. This will be monitored.

These instructions are for the comfort of our members and golfers, but importantly for the safety and wellbeing of our staff and volunteers, can you please ensure you respect them.
