Entries are invited for this competition subject to The General Conditions of Entry 2023 and the following particular conditions:

This is a strokeplay competition, played over 36 holes from the White fixed permanent tee markers.

Tee times will be reserved morning & afternoon.

White Course handicap limit is 12, all competitors play from scratch.

Entry Fee is £4

(entry payment must be made by the entry Deadline Date, any entrant who's payment has not been received will not be entered into the draw)

Entry Deadline - Sunday (to be advised) 2023

The winner will receive the Braime Trophy for one year and a prize voucher. Runner Up and further subsidiary prize vouchers will be awarded dependant upon the number of entrants

Restricted, Five day and Country members are NOT eligible.

Nelson Grimshaw Scratch Cup and Fryer Cup

The 8 competitors with the best gross scores over 36 holes will qualify for the Nelson Grimshaw Scratch Cup

The 8 competitors with the best nett scores not already qualifying for the Nelson Grimshaw Scratch Cup will qualify for the Fryer Cup.

Draws will be made for the matchplay stages

These are knockout competitions, decided by Match Play over 18 holes, the Nelson Grimshaw played off the White Course **fixed permanent tee markers**, the Fryer Cup played off the White Course **tees of the day**, with both finals being played over 36 Holes on Final's Day.

Both competitors share the joint responsibility of contacting their opponent and ensuring the match is played and result reached before the closing date.

In the event of failure to agree a date, the match shall commence at 5pm on the last day of the round and any competitor failing to start at this time will be disqualified.

Matches that are All Square after 18 or 36 (as applicable) must be decided by the 'Sudden Death' method starting at No. 1 tee and a result obtained on the same day. In the event that play has to be suspended for an 'acceptable reason', the General Conditions of Entry 2023 will apply

The winner of each match is responsible for ensuring that his name appears on the draw sheet on or before the closing date for the particular round. Failure to do so will result in both competitors being eliminated.

Postponement of the final will only be sanctioned in exceptional circumstances such as a competitor reaching the final of another GGC competition or a competitor being selected to represent the L&DUGC, the County Union or higher.

Except as above, in the event of a competitor becoming aware that they will be unavailable to participate on Finals' Day, they must immediately withdraw from the competition.

The winners will receive the Nelson Grimshaw Scratch Cup/Fryer Cup for one year and a prize voucher. The runners up will also receive prize vouchers.

Restricted, Five day and Country members are NOT eligible.
