Clacton on Sea Golf Club <u>Lounge Bar Dress Code</u> <u>Effective 1st July 2019</u>

1 – All men's shirts must have a collar

2 – <u>No</u> Golf Shoes. <u>No</u> informal rubber beach style flip flops or general beach footwear. Smart leather sandals and single post shoes can be worn provided in general they fit in with the Golf Club ethos. Sandals and clean trainers are allowed. Bare feet or socks only are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u>

3 – Hoodies, hats or any headgear or general beach style wear of any sort are **NOT ALLOWED**

4 – Jogging bottoms, shell suits or any gym style wear clothing are **NOT ALLOWED**

5 – Smart jeans are allowed. Any other jeans with tears, holes or frayed are **NOT ALLOWED**

6 – Clean, dry golf clothing (including tailored shorts) can be worn. Soiled or wet clothing is **NOT ALLOWED**

7 – Preferably, all coats or other such garments should be hung in the changing rooms or on rails when and where provided and not on the backs of chairs.

8 – Football/Rugby/Sports type jerseys cannot be worn as the norm. When sporting events are being advertised and televised at the Club, members can wear sporting tops with prior permission from the Club/when the Club designates a relaxed dress code for the event

9 – **DISCRETION**: the staff on duty have full authority to refuse entry into the Lounge Bar if in their opinion members or guests are not correctly dressed. This may vary between staff members, but it is the staff on the day and their opinion on the day that counts. There is no appeal against this, what they say goes, please do not argue with staff or abuse them over their decisions. These rules can be waived at the discretion of any Golf Club Board member, the Bar Manager or 19th Catering Management, but only for good reason and on "one-off" occasions and must not be considered the norm.

10 – Food can only be eaten at the tables in the lounge or restaurant, not at the bar. Only light snacks, peanuts, crisps and the Sunday trays provided by the Club can be eaten at the bar.

Stud Bar & Patio area Dress Code

As above: but flip flops and smart round neck shirts are allowed.

Please note if you proceed into the Lounge Bar incorrectly dressed, the staff have been authorised not to serve you and to report you to the Chief Executive who may escalate any discretions to the disciplinary committee where a ban from the Golf Club could result. Foul and abusive language is unacceptable behaviour anywhere on the Golf Club premises and if reported might also lead to disciplinary action
