

15th O'Meara – Approach Shots across River


Shot 1 (Purple Line): Ball crosses Red Penalty area. Options: (a) Replay the shot (b) drop ball at reference point (agree with playing partner) or (c) use drop zone. All 1 shot penalties.

Shot 2 (Red Line): Ball crosses Yellow Penalty Area and spins back into river. Options: (a) Replay the shot (b) Player may take back-on-the-line relief (white dotted line) between you, reference point and flag or (c) use drop zone. All 1 shot penalties.

Shot 3 (Gold Line): Ball crosses Yellow Penalty Area and runs down back of green into river. Options: (a) Replay the shot (b) or (c) use drop zone. Both 1 shot penalties. Note: No option available to player to take back-on-the-line relief between you, reference point and flag.

Note: You must agree with playing partner(s) on tee where the ball crossed red stakes taking account of Carton Local rule (below) and R&A guidance and - *Known or virtually certain* means all reasonably available information shows that it is at least 95% likely that the event in question happened.

If the player is aware that the only possible place the original ball could be lost is in a penalty area, **a provisional ball is not allowed** and a ball played from where the previous stroke was made becomes the player's ball in play under penalty of stroke and distance (see [Rule 18.1](#)).
