Use of County Cards at Seascale

County Cards are accepted at Seascale with limitations on frequency and timings as per guidance from participating County Unions and Cumbrian Union of Golf Clubs**. Only County Cards sponsored by County Unions are accepted e.g not the *National County Card*.

- Visitors may use their County Cards on only one occasion in any particular year.
- The name and number on each County Card used will be recorded along with date and time of use. Proof of identity may be requested.
- Groups limited to up to 4 players and may not be used in connection with larger groups or societies.
- Pre-booking at least 24 hours in advance is required and tee times depend on availability.
- County Cards may be used according to the following timings and greenfee rates:

**Currently, County Unions have over 1,300 clubs who host County Card Members extending the benefit of the County Card to golfers from participating clubs in Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Cheshire, Cumbria, Derbyshire, Devon, Dorset, Durham, Essex, Gloucestershire, Hampshire, Hertfordshire, Kent, Lancashire, Leicestershire & Rutland, Middlesex, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire, Northumberland, Nottinghamshire, Shropshire & Herefordshire, Somerset, Staffordshire, Surrey, Sussex, Warwickshire, Wiltshire, Worcestershire and Yorkshire.

- Members aged 18 and over of Affiliated Clubs may join the scheme only if their own Club has agreed to act as a host.
- County Card Members may play at least once at any of the Host Clubs on the list (some Host Clubs may allow more than one visit).
- Bookings must be made in advance with the Host Club. Restrictions on time and day of the week may apply. In general, bookings will not be accepted for weekends or Bank Holidays.
- The green fee to be charged is entirely at the discretion of the host Club. Typically, the green fee will be 50% of the visitor rate, or the same as the 'guest' green fee.
- County Card Members must have current handicaps and must agree to be bound by the rules of the Club being visited.
- The County Card may only be used for groups of up to 4 players and may not be used in connection with larger groups or societies.
- County Cards are not transferrable.
- Clubs have the right to refuse the card at their own discretion. Any abuse of staff which may arise will be reported to that player's own club.
