## INTER CLUB DELEGATES MEETING REPORT.

Hopefully we are getting back to some sort of normality for this year's Inter Club Championship.

I would like to remind you that the fixture forms are due by the **15<sup>th of</sup> March**, please return these if you have not already done so. If you have sent in your form, you will have received an acknowledgement, the form is available on the website

The closing date for all matches to be played is the 28<sup>th of</sup> July.

All forms were possible will now be done electronically.

I would also like to remind you of the handicap index limits for 2022.

SCRATCH League - 7 Players	Up to 36.4 HI
A League - 7 Players	Up to 25.4 HI
B League - 7 Players	18.5 to 36.4 HI
WHITE ROSE League - 5 Players	Up to 36.4 HI
Weekend League - 3 Players	Up to 36.4 HI

Players are **NOT** eligible if their HI is above the maximum for that league.

Clubs may enter two teams in any league, but players cannot be interchanged between the teams in the same league. However, players can be interchanged between different leagues, HI permitting.

Any player whose HI reduces below 18.5 having played in a B team match in this year can continue to play in the B team matches using their new HI.

If a team concedes a match more than **ONCE** in the year the Executive will refuse entry for the following year for that team in that league.

It is permissible for any team in the Scratch, A and B leagues to field a team of SIX players ONCE in the year, in the White Rose league Four players and the Weekend league TWO. If a team fields a team of six (four or two) more than once in the year the Executive will refuse entry for the following year for that team in that league.

The draw has been based on near and mid distance; this is totally dependent on the location of clubs entering the leagues.

Please make sure you can fully support the teams you enter. Entries for 2023 need to be in by the **15<sup>th</sup> of August 2022**, any changes in terms of competition will be advised by July 2022.

If you are unsure of supporting a team of 7 players, then we would encourage you to seriously consider the White Rose league. This league is up to a maximum of 36.4 HI and just 5 players therefore making it much easier to be able to support a team. It also has finals in the same way as the other leagues and is of the same high status.

Full Terms of Competition will be in the 2022 Handbook.

I would like to remind you that the Delegates meetings really are the forum for putting your questions forward and we always welcome your views. So please, have your say at the meetings or, if you don't want to voice your opinions in front of others, send an email or letter. I can assure you every suggestion/view is taken seriously and discussed thoroughly. But, without your Input it makes the decision making that much harder.
