An eagle and two birdies helped Peter Bowerman (12) to victory with 41 points, also earning a 1 shot handicap reduction. Alex Carter (6) was a point behind in second place, recovering superbly from a shaky start with an eagle and three birdies by the tenth hole. Kjeld Rasmussen (8) was third with 39 points, ahead of Jason Taylor (scratch) in fourth with 36 points.

Congratulations to Michael Rhodes who is this year's winner of the Quaich Trophy following an excellent final with Art Severn, which needed two extra holes to decide the outcome. History repeated itself for Art who lost at the same stage last year, but, like last year, he had been victorious in the Mixed Foursomes final.

The Men's Summer Foursomes Trophy is the only remaining knockout competition which has not yet been decided. The delayed final, which will be played in October, will be contested by Steve Dodds and Richard Hanson who will play Peter Jesper and Gus Dunlop.

There was a good turnout last Friday for the Winter Foursomes Supper Auction, at which presenters Ron Potts, Ronnie Caldwell, Bruce Allison and Mike Starkings humourously summarised the talents (or otherwise!) of the 37 drawn pairings. This was followed by the auction, where members bid for "ownership" of the pairings.
