Muti-Tee's :

Starting on Monday 5th July we will be having the John Kennedy Motors Singles (Multi Tee's Blue and Green option). This competition will continue on Tuesday 6th July and on Thursday 8th July. So, Blue Tee's are now for everyone. With the move to the WHS we are now in a position to offer multi tee options during competition. What does this mean for every golfer? During multi tee competitions a player will receive a handicap adjustment after calculating their playing handicap. That adjustment varies depending on the format of the competition but let's not gets bogged down in that for now. For the John Kennedy

Motors Singles there will be a multi tee option with Blue Tee's and Green Tee's on offer. So why play off Blues you ask...? With your handicap index already likely giving you an extra shot(s) playing the Blues, the multi tee adjustment will add another 1.4 to your playing handicap (for the maths wizards this is the difference in the two course ratings). To take an example of a player with a 15.0 Handicap index, that player has the option to play from the Greens off a playing handicap of 15 or from the Blues with a playing handicap of 17. Finally rest assured that the computer will handle the maths part, no need for the calculator's just yet.

For the Coolmore Stud 4-man Scramble being played on Friday 9th, Sat 10th and Sun 11th, the 85% of Course Handicap to give you your Playing Handicap will also apply. BRS for the Sat 10th and Sun 11th will open this evening Friday at 19:30.
