

## **WINTER PAIRS COMPETITION FOR THE PRESIDENTS CUP ( 2020 - 2021 )**

This competition will take place during the winter months, October through to March inclusive.

All rounds will be the same format, playing in pairs:

**4 Ball Better Ball Stableford                      Play off WHITE TEE**

**Play off 85% individual handicap. (85% because of WHS implementation in November).**

The winners will be determined by the best 4 cards (of up to 6 cards) during the qualifying months.

**This year the competition will run over 2 periods. The entry fee is £6.00 per pair.**

You can do a minimum of 2 cards before the New Year, and a minimum of 2 cards after the New Year. The two remaining cards can be done at anytime within the 6 months period.

**Play is not allowed if there are temporary greens with bucket holes in place, although play is allowed if the 6<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> holes only are on temporary greens (with normal sized holes).**

**Enter using the Club V1 app to book your tee time in the usual way. You MUST sign into the competition in the pro's shop on the day you are going to play each of your rounds. Please mark your score cards clearly, and state whether it is your 1<sup>st</sup> card, 2<sup>nd</sup> card, 3<sup>rd</sup> cards, etc up to the 6<sup>th</sup> card. Also record the date of your round on your card.**

**Please leave your score cards in the score-card box.**

**Juniors may play but must be paired with an adult member.**

**Obviously, you can only enter if you have an active handicap.**

There will be no winners for any particular month.

At the end of the competition if pairs have the same total scores count back will take place from the last round back to the first round (using the best 4 scores)

The winner of the event will win the Presidents Cup.

Prize money will be divided 2/3<sup>rd</sup>s to the winning pair, 1/3<sup>rd</sup> to the runners up.

If, over 25 pairs enter the competition, the prize money will be divided 50%, 30% and 20%.

Interim results will be published at the end of December.
