Sale of Donnington Grove - A lot more interest and Viewings ongoing.

Electricity repairs - Moving forward, generators should be gone soon.

4. Director of Golf Report.

Continuing with course consultant, good progress with available funds. A lot of good comments coming from both members and visitors on course condition.

DP World Tour qualifier coming in September.

Work started on course set up for the event, changes will include lowered cutting heights of fairways and greens, raised cutting heights of first and second cuts lining fairways and some rough areas left to grow. Some bunkers require more sand and the greens are to be running at around 10.5 stimp. Tee boxes are requested to be cut in a diamond pattern. This will all enhance the presentation of the course as well as making playability suitable for the qualifier.

Water leaks on 9, 11 and 16 have now been fixed. Fairways have been fertilised.

Maintenance week starts on Monday 14th, and course will be closed on Wednesday 16th. Work will include weeding bunkers and coring tees.

Winter work planned for course includes enlarging the 1st tee, possible alteration of the cross bunker on the 4th and replacing of bunker on corner of 6th.

It is also planned to core and sand greens 6 times over the winter period, this should enable greens to be rolled more often, cut lower and lead to a truer flatter roll, thus increasing the speed.

Tree canopies will continue to be raised, and the cores from tees and greens will be saved and used to build some permanent winter Tees for ladies, for example on the 13th.

A few tees are not so level now and may be looked at in the future.

Upcoming club events include Pro Am on 1st September and Invitation day on 15th

TF requested committee members assist by keeping an eye out for small misdemeanours on the course and help to educate the members, for example, trollies being taken on tees and between bunkers and greens.

Many walkers on and around the course in the summer, many not sticking to the footpaths, signage may need updating in some areas. Dog mess still an issue on some parts of 13th and 14th.
