# Competitions

## Conditions and Regulations

**These procedures may be modified  
when special playing conditions are imposed.**

The purpose of the Handicap and Competitions Committee, hereafter referred to as the Committee, is to undertake the regulation and administration of competitions and members' handicaps.

The Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrew's shall be the rules of Brickhampton Court Golf Club, together with local rules detailed on the score cards and posted in the Clubhouse, which themselves are within the Rules of Golf. Competitions are open to seven-day, five-day, Flexi and Twilight members with a current Handicap Index unless stated otherwise within these Conditions and Regulations. Five-day members may play in weekend competitions subject to the payment of the appropriate Green Fee in addition to the competition entry fee.

### **Formats and Conditions**

The format and conditions of entry for all Club competitions will be set out on Competition Information Sheets that will be posted on a club noticeboard. Changes to the format of existing Club competitions will only be made after Committee and General Committee approval.

All players who enter a competition accept that they may be required to play in the same team or group as any other player that has entered.

### **Entry Qualification for Club Honours Board Competitions (Majors)**

To enter a Club Honours Board (Major) Competition, which are defined in the Fixture List, a member must have three scoring 18-hole rounds in qualifying individual strokeplay competitions on their golf record during the twelve-month period prior to the date that entries close for the competition.

The qualifying rounds on a player's golf record may be from:

- Brickhampton Court Club Competitions (which are those denoted with 'Q' in the Fixture List and are indicated as such on the Competition Information Sheets).
- Away qualifying competitions, (such as County events or individual Opens), organised by an affiliated Club or Union.

If a new member can provide a current playing record that includes three qualifying competitions at an Affiliated Golf Club, the Committee may, once satisfied with the details provided, allow the member to participate in Honour Board Competitions using the existing qualifying rounds on their record.

Any member failing to meet the above may, at the discretion of the Committee, participate in an Honours Board Competition and count it as a qualifier on their golf record for Club Majors, but they will not be eligible to win any prizes in that competition.

Flexi and Twilight Members may not enter Club Major Competitions.

## Entry Fees

Entry fees for Club competitions will be determined by the Committee and these will be shown on the Competition Information Sheet produced for each competition.

- For Club Majors and Monthly Medal competitions the entry fees will be split evenly between the Trophy fund, Prize fund and Club fund.
- For all other competitions (excluding Club Night) the entry fees will be split evenly between the Prize fund and Club fund.
- For Club Night £2.50 will go into the Prize fund and £0.50 will go into the Club fund.

## Handicap Requirements for Competition Entry

The handicap limits for entry is shown on each Competition Information Sheet.

### Entry Procedures

The Entry Procedures for competitions will be in accordance with the Competitions Payment and Entry Procedures, a copy of which can be found in the Members Lounge under Club Policies & Procedures and in the Members Information File. This requires members to keep their competition accounts in credit, from which entry fees will be deducted at the time shown on the Competition Information Sheet produced for each competition. A member who fails to enter a competition in the specified manner may be deemed to have neither a score for the competition nor a score for handicap purposes.

### Drawn Competitions

Competition Information Sheets for all drawn competitions will be placed on the appropriate noticeboard approximately six weeks in advance of the competition date and entry will be via the PSI, HowDiDiDo or ClubV1 Members Hub unless specified otherwise.

No entries will be accepted after the closing date specified on the Competition Information Sheet. If a member who has missed the deadline would like to join a reserve list, they should contact the Handicap and Competitions Secretary.

**When entering a drawn competition players are accepting that they could be playing with any other participant and at any of the tee times allocated for the competition.**

On the closing date for entries the Committee will check that any relevant qualifying criteria has been met by entrants and conduct a draw. Start times will be posted on the appropriate noticeboard or ClubV1 Members Hub approximately one week prior to the date of the competition. Changes to these times can only be made by the Committee.

A competitor who is unable to play for any reason must inform the appropriate Committee member as soon as possible:

- For Club competitions email [bcgcompsec@gmail.com](mailto:bcgcompsec@gmail.com).
- For Seniors competitions email [bcgcsensec@gmail.com](mailto:bcgcsensec@gmail.com).

Withdrawing without notice will lead to a two-competition ban unless specified differently on the relevant Competition Information Sheet.

In a drawn pairs competition, if one of the pair is unable to play it is the responsibility of the partner to arrive at the allocated tee-time to mark the other pairs score card. Failure to do so will result in a two-competition ban for both players.

### Non-Drawn Competitions

For non-drawn competitions, the Competition Information Sheet will be displayed about two weeks before the date of the competition and members are required to book their own tee-times.

Unless otherwise specified on the Competition Information Sheet members must sign in (as directed using the PSI, HowDiDiDo or ClubV1 Members Hub) before the commencement of play.

### **Club Knock-Out Competitions (for Seniors see their procedure)**

It is expected that all knock-out competitions will be arranged and played in a mature and sporting manner, with consideration being given to opponent's circumstances.

#### **No player should enter a knock-out competition if:**

- They cannot provide reasonable availability to meet the close dates for each competition round.
- They are unable to play on the finals day (which is specified in the Fixture List).
- There is a risk that, later, they might have to withdraw.

If a player's circumstances change once the competition has started, **they must withdraw immediately and not play any further rounds**. For the Club knock-out they must promptly notify the Handicap and Competition Secretary (Seniors follow their procedure). In this event, the opponent(s) that they would have played at the point of withdrawal will be declared the winners and progress to the next round.

At the time a player becomes unable to play on the finals day and fails to withdraw immediately, they will be banned from entering any of the knock-out competitions the following year.

In all knock-out competitions both the first named player(s) and their opponent(s) are equally responsible for arranging the date and time of their match.

If a player is unable to contact their opponent(s), or in case of dispute, they should contact the Handicap and Competition Secretary as soon as possible and no later than seven days before the closing date of the round. If the players are unable to agree, all will be disqualified and the opponent(s) that would have played the winners in the next round will be granted a bye to the subsequent round.

There will be no extensions to the closing date of any round of a knock-out competition, except:

- If the course has been closed for any reason for a period of time, the closing date for that round and any subsequent round(s) may be extended by the Committee.
- If a player who reaches the Final of the knock-out competition suffers an injury and is unable to play at the time arranged, the Committee may, with the agreement of the opponent(s), postpone the match for a reasonable period.

In all disputes, the decision of the Handicap and Competitions Secretary will be final.

### **Team Competitions**

In 2024 England Golf are making changes to the way team competition scores are being recorded and used for handicap purposes. This includes, but is not exclusive to, 4BBB and Bowmakers. At time of going to press the full details are not available however, the methodology for including these rounds for qualification purposes will be explained in full at the Members Information Evenings and will be sent to all members via email.

### **Senior Members**

Weekly competitions are arranged by the Seniors in accordance with these regulations, but they have supplementary organisational requirements as specified in the Seniors Competitions Procedures, which can be found in the Members Lounge under Club Policies & Procedures and the Members Information File.

## **Junior Members**

Junior Members must hold an official WHS handicap index to be eligible to enter adult Club competitions and the Junior member's card must be marked by an adult member.

## **Return of Score Cards**

After completion of a competitive round, members are responsible for ensuring the score card is correctly completed, signed and returned to the designated place as specified on the Competition Information Sheet or as instructed by a starter. The default is to return score cards to the lectern.

Failure to enter scores in either the PSI, HowDiDiDo or ClubV1 Members Hub, as specified on the Competition Information Sheet or as instructed by a starter, may result in being disqualified from the competition and incur a two-competition ban as decided by the Committee. The card will still count for handicapping purposes.

No cards will be accepted after the day of the competition unless otherwise agreed with the Handicap and Competition Secretary. If the Clubhouse is closed, members should put the completed score card in the post box situated outside the entrance to the Clubhouse.

All score cards must be returned whether the round has been completed or not. Failure to return a correctly completed score card will result in disqualification from the competition and a further two-competition ban.

## **Close of Competitions and Determination of Results**

After the completion of a competition, the Committee will review the returned score cards and determine the result which will be available on HowDiDiDo, ClubV1 Members Hub or via email as appropriate. The outcome of all competitions is placed in the Results folder, which can be found in the lectern. Members can use Apps from HowDiDiDo, ClubV1 Members Hub or England Golf to access their handicap records.

## **Number of Entries**

On closure of a competition, the Committee will review the number of entrants:

- If there are less than five entrants in a competition, then the competition will be cancelled. Members who have entered will be refunded. If it is a qualifying single strokeplay competition, their scores will still count for handicapping purposes and count as a qualifying competition for entry to club Majors.
- If there are between six and nineteen entrants to a competition, the result will be determined on an overall basis (i.e., there will be no divisions).
- If there are twenty or more entrants to a competition, the result will be split into divisions as determined by the Committee.
- If there are at least [five] ladies' entrants in a monthly medal competition, a separate Ladies Division will be created by the Committee.

Prizes will be determined by the Committee and monetary prizes will be paid into the member's competition account.

## **General Play Round Scores**

Members are encouraged to regularly submit score cards from general play rounds to ensure that their Handicap Index reflects their current playing ability. Members may submit an unlimited number of general play rounds throughout the year and these may be played as Medal or Stableford.

The following procedures apply:

- Members **must** sign-in via PSI, HowDiDiDo, ClubV1 Members Hub or the England Golf MyEG golf app **before** they go out to play.
- Members must select the tee they are going to play off when signing in for a General Play round.
- On completion of the round, scores must be entered using the same system they signed in on (i.e., if you sign-in on the PSI you enter your scores on the PSI).
- If scores are entered on the PSI, score cards must be returned to the lectern fully completed.
- If a score is not entered the round will not count and a Penalty Score will be added by England Golf.

### **Local Rules**

Local rules can be found on the back of the score cards. New local rules for 2024:

- On hole 1 if the ball rests in a hole in the sleepers this is treated as ground under repair. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.
- Driving Range fencing and support posts are immovable obstructions and the player may take relief without penalty under Rule 16.1.
- Course directions must be followed at all times. There is no access to the 13th tee by crossing behind the 15th green and players must exit the 15th green to the left and not past the 13th tees. A General Penalty may be applied.

In all club competitions scorecards must be completed in full. This includes handicap index, Stableford points (in Stableford competitions) and all columns totalled.

### **A Reminder**

Players are expected to:

- Act with integrity by following the Rules of Handicapping and to refrain from using, or circumventing, the Rules of Handicapping for the purposes of gaining an unfair advantage.
- Attempt to make the best score possible at each hole.
- Submit acceptable scores for handicapping purposes as soon as possible after the round is completed and before midnight local time.
- Submit sufficient acceptable scores to provide reasonable evidence of their demonstrated ability.
- Play by the Rules of Golf.
- Certify the scores of fellow players.

The Club may act under WHS Rules of Handicapping Rule 7 against any member who fails to maintain this high standard.

### **Amendments**

Amendments may be made from time to time in these Conditions and Regulations and these will be displayed in the Members Lounge under Club Policies & Procedures and Members Information File, which all members are requested to read.
