

WALKER CUP

This competition will be played on courses stipulated by the Committee. This is open to all male members who are over aged 55 and played under the Rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Competition Rules, Local Club and Committee Rules. Play to be from the White Tees.

The Walker Cup is a Stableford competition played over 18 holes in one Division 0-24 playing handicap. Three rounds will be played on the Hawkstone Course and three rounds on the Championship Course.

The winner is the player with the most points over a total of 3 rounds (one of which must be on either course).

The Trophy will be awarded to the winner and prize money credited to competition account for appropriate winners as an 80/20 percentage split of the competition fund.

Presentation will be at the Annual Dinner. Winners are expected to attend.

Entry to this competition will be via the PSI Touch Screen/HowDidiDo App on the day of the competition at a cost agreed by the Committee.

On completion of the round scores are to be entered on to the PSI Touch Screen or a maximum of 6 hours after respective tee time on HowDidiDo App.

In the event of a tie a back 9 count back will be used to determine a result, if this is not successful back 6/3/1 will be used. The Committee's decision will be final.
