EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1 To be eligible to win Honours Board events, members must have an Active Handicap. New members joining from another Club will be required to produce a Handicap Certificate showing their current handicap.
- 2 The Golf Sub-Committee will act in accordance with the requirements of the Unified Handicapping System (UHS) of the Council of National Golf Unions (CONGU). In accordance with CONGU Rules, members with Inactive Handicaps may compete in Qualifying Rounds of Stroke Play competitions but their scores will not count towards qualification for Trophies, Honours Board Competitions or Finals.
- 3 Definition Qualified Juniors are Juniors with a CONGU Handicap of 12 or less OR who have attained the age of 18 on the date of the competition.
- 4 Qualified Juniors may play in all stroke play competitions except the Leslie Davis Stableford. Eligibility to play is defined in this Annexe, and will be indicated on the Start Sheet.
- 5 In competitions regulated by a Starting Sheet, commencement of play shall be strictly in accordance with the times posted on the sheet. Failure to comply with this rule may lead to disqualification. A member who fails to appear for a reserved starting time without reasonable excuse shall be required to pay the appropriate Entry Fee and may be suspended from Competitions at the discretion of the Golf Sub-Committee.
- 6 In Knockout Competitions, it is the responsibility of <u>both</u> sides to offer at least 3 dates, one of which should be at a weekend.
- 7 All competitions are played off white tees unless stated
- 8 "Golfer of the Year" qualifying competitions are marked *
- 9 All handicap allowances will be in line with CONGU directives
