For those of you who haven't qualified for the Beswick Finals, there will be a subsidiary stableford with the usual £2:50 entry fee. Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entrants.

You can sign up to play with ladies who are in either competition.

In addition, there will be the usual 9 Hole Stableford competition - £1:50 entry fee.
