

MEN'S SECTION BOOKING AND COMPETITION RULES



1. Silverware Competitions

All Silverware competition tee times will be fully drawn in groups of three. The draw will take place on the evening or the morning after the competition closes, normally two days before the day of the competition. After the draw has been made, a member can be added through the Pro-Shop to any tee time that has only two members allocated. In no case can a three ball be added.

All members without live handicaps, and in team competitions those without named partners (A. N. Other), are not included in the draw.

Juniors with a handicap of 6 or less can play in the Men's Silverware Knockout and General Competitions.

Juniors with a handicap of 7 to 12 can play in the Men's General Silverware Competitions (i.e. not the Duguid Cup, Foursomes and Fourballs).

Juniors who are aged 16 to 18 with a current handicap of 28 or less can play in the Men's "General" Silverware Competitions.

*Tee Times:

07.30 to 09.22, 13.00 to 14.15 and 16.00 to 16.15 which are all drawn.
Play from White Tees.

2. Monthly Medals

Monthly medal tee times will include both draw and non-draw options. The draw will take place on the evening or the morning after the competition closes, normally two days before the day of the competition. After the draw has been made, a member/s can be added through the Pro-Shop to any tee time that has only two members allocated, or, to any available tee time outside of the original draw and before the stated competition closing time.

Juniors between the ages of 16 and 18 who have attained a handicap of 28 or less can play in men's medals.

*Tee Times:

April; 08.00 to 08.52 Draw, 09.00 to 09.30 Non-Draw, 13.00 to 13.22 and 16.00 to 16.30 will be shared Draw & Non-Draw. From May 07.30 to 07.52 Non-Draw is added.
Play from White Tees.

3. Extra Medals and Stablefords

Extra Medals and Stableford tee times will include both draw and non-draw options. The draw will take place on the evening or the morning after the competition closes, normally two days before the day of the competition. After the draw has been made, a member/s can be added through the Pro-Shop to any tee time that has only two members allocated, or, to any available tee time outside of the original draw and before the stated competition closing time.

Juniors between the ages of 16 and 18 who have attained a handicap of 28 or less can play in men's medals.

*Tee Times:

April; 08.00 to 08.52 Draw, 09.00 to 09.30 Non-Draw, 13.00 to 13.22 and 16.00 to 16.30 will be shared Draw & Non-Draw. From May 07.30 to 07.52 Non-Draw is added.

Play from White or Yellow Tees.
