Please make yourself and all of your players aware of the following Terms and Conditions: -

An indication of the number of players taking part should be notified to the Office when the booking is confirmed.

**Exact numbers must be advised 3 days before the meeting. These are the numbers that will be invoiced** (unless there has been a mutual agreement to increase the numbers). If your group falls below the advised number, then catering costs will need to be covered. Green fees may be adjusted accordingly.

Bookings will only be accepted on the return of the official booking forms accompanied by the requested deposit. Payment should be made to the Office or Bar Steward on the day, allowances will be made in respect of Green Fees for Members of Shirley Park Golf Club who may be participating in the Society's meeting.

**Any cancellation must be made in writing two months before the organised date,** the deposit may be accepted as a cancellation charge. If less than 2 months notice is given we will require 50% of the total package cost. Play will be from the Yellow Tee markers and starting Tee(s) will be booked for a fixed period, according to the size of Society and format of play. Starting times will not be earlier than 8.30am depending on the booking, and may be subject to alteration if circumstances dictate. Breakfast is only available before 10am if booked as part of your package.

All members of your Society must abide by all club rules and dress code (please see attached). We reserve the right to ask any guest not abiding by these rules to leave the club house/golf course. Please ensure all golfers receive a copy.

It is expected that members of all visiting Societies will be reasonably experienced golfers who are fully conversant with the etiquette and rules of golf.

Local rules applying at the time of the meeting must be observed and we only allow wide wheel trolleys.

Slow play must be avoided and players losing distance to the extent that a hole ahead is clear must call the players following through.

All divots and pitch marks are to be replaced and repaired and bunkers smoothed after use. The Club cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to visitor's property.

The attention of all Society Secretaries is drawn to the fact that no vans or lorries are permitted in the Club car park, cars should only be parked in the specifically marked bays indicated in the car park.

No reductions can be made if inclement weather, including frost and frozen conditions, affects your golf day, in any way, unless the course is closed.

On behalf of the Golf Society, I hereby accept the Terms and Conditions and details outlined in the society literature. I enclose our deposit to secure my booking; I also confirm that all members of the Society will be briefed on dress code and etiquette.

#### Dress Code for the course

The requirement is smart golf dress, proper golf shoes, shirts with collars and sleeves may be worn outside tailored shorts or trousers. Tailored shorts may be worn with short white socks. No other sports shorts, jeans, tracksuits, shell suits or trousers tucked into socks are permitted.

The use of mobile phones on the course is not permitted. If, for some reason, such units are retained on your person, they must be switched off.

Golf shoes can be worn in the Players Bar and Locker Rooms but not in any other areas of the clubhouse.

## Etiquette

It is expected that members of all visiting Societies will be reasonably experienced golfers who are fully conversant with the etiquette and rules of golf.

Local rules applying at the time of the meeting must be observed and we allow only wide wheeled trolleys.

Slow play must be avoided at all times and players losing distance to the extent that a hole ahead is clear must call the following players through. All divots are to be replaced, pitch marks repaired and bunkers smoothed after use.


### Dress Code for the clubhouse

Smart casual dress is permitted in all areas of the clubhouse and tailored shirts may be worn outside the trousers but jackets with shirt and tie must be worn in the dining room. Smart casual dress excludes wet and soiled golf wear, jeans, trainers, sandals (with or without socks), T-shirts, track suits, shell suits, collarless shirts, as well as zip-up and out-door type jackets.

Members and visitors are required to change out of golf wear that has just been worn on the course before using the Lounge or Dining Room. The use of mobile phones is not permitted in any area of the Clubhouse except beside the public phone kiosk (at the main entrance) and both locker rooms.

Smoking is not permitted in any part of the Clubhouse but we do have a heated smoking area on our patio.





Smart casual dress is permitted in all areas of the clubhouse including the dining room (tailored shirts may be worn outside trousers). Jackets with shirt and tie must be worn in the dining room at all Club Matches, Club Functions and Society Meetings. Smart casual dress excludes wet and soiled golf wear, jeans, trainers, sandals (with or without socks), T-shirts, track suits, shell suits, collarless shirts, as well as zip-up and outdoor jackets.

Members and visitors are required to change out of golf wear which has just been worn on the course before using the Lounge or Dining Room. Relaxation of these rules on specific occasions is only at the discretion of the board.

Food requiring a knife and fork must be eaten in the dining room or the designated dining area adjacent to it.

Sandwiches may be eaten in all areas.

Mobile phones are not permitted in any area of the Clubhouse except beside the public phone kiosk (at the main entrance) and in the locker rooms.
