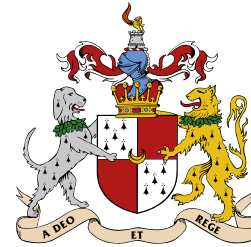
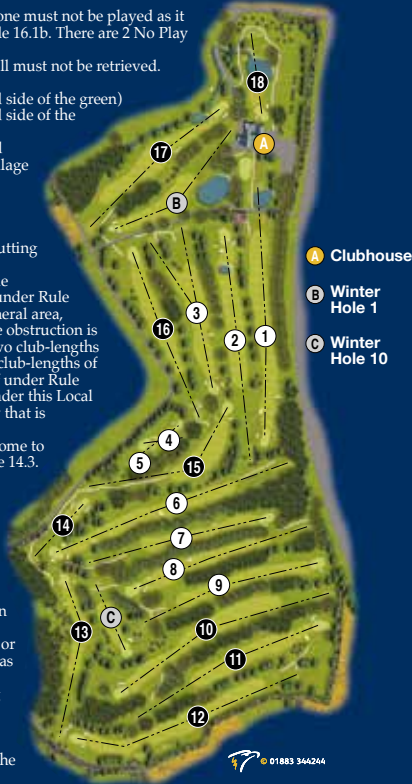


## EREWASH VALLEY GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

- The public footpath crossing holes 1, 2, 3 and any tractor or heavy vehicle marks or tracks in the rough or fairway are treated as immovable obstructions and the ball may be lifted and dropped under Rule 16.1. The public footpath between holes 6 & 15 and crossing 14 is an integral part of the course.
- Direction Posts are Movable Obstructions. Direction Posts installed as fixed, for practical reasons, are Immovable Obstructions and free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. Relief is not allowed to be taken under Rule 15.2.
- Protection of trees identified by either stakes or guide wires – the ball must be lifted, and free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. The ball must be lifted, dropped and come to rest in the 'relief area' according to Rule 14.3. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- Any ball coming to rest in a No Play Zone must not be played as it lies, and relief must be taken under Rule 16.1b. There are 2 No Play Zones:
- The rockfall area in The Quarry. The ball must not be retrieved.  
Free relief is taken as follows:  
Playing hole 4: Drop Zone 1 (left hand side of the green)  
Playing hole 5: Drop Zone 2 (left hand side of the tee). The drop zones are Relief Areas.
- The area of grasses and flowers beyond Crompton green and on the front of Village Pound tee, defined by green stakes.  
The hut beyond Crompton green is an integral part of the course.
- Immovable Obstructions close to the Putting Green  
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and free relief is allowed under Rule 16-1. In addition, if a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)  
The ball must be lifted, dropped, and come to rest in the 'relief area' according to Rule 14.3.
- Out of Bounds
  - Into or out of the Quarry, including Quarry tees.
  - Beyond the white posts and/ or white line on the left of Village Pound, to the left of the fairway on Summers & The Mounds, also beyond the white post next to the tee on Stanton.
  - Over any boundary fence or hedge, on or beyond the line of vertical roots, taken as the centre line.
  - Into or over any ditch or gap bounding the course.
  - Any ball crossing a boundary hedge or fence, on holes 1, 12, 14, 16, 17, 18 onto a public highway must be reported to the Professional.
