1. Minutes of previous Meetings

The minute of the meeting held on 21st March 2022 was approved by Raymond Cowan and seconded by Gary Pacitti

2. Matters arising.

Greens: Drop zone has now been added to the area behind 12th green.

Slow play: a couple of those present had recently played behind the member in question and found there to be no issues whatsoever that could warrant "a word".

Committee: No responses received to the invite sent out. Agreed therefore that this subject matter is now closed for the current Committee year.
