1. General

As we know, the Government are lifting all restrictions from 19th July 2021. Though this is great news, we still need to be responsible as infections in the local area are growing and we have had two instances of COVID on site in the last 4 weeks. The protocols we have in place clearly work as we have not had any outbreaks.

- We advise members and guests to wear a facemask when moving around inside the clubhouse.
- Members are advised to use hand sanitiser at every opportunity. This will continue to be available around the clubhouse and at all entrances.
- Social distancing is still encouraged when indoors.

2. Bar

- Table service will be removed for casual drinking/dining.
- Service at the bar with one person from the group to come up.
- There will be no sitting or standing at the bar unless being served.
- Screens across the bar will remain up.
- QR Codes will remain available but will not be compulsory.
- No longer need to sign in with the staff upon arrival, you can go directly to your table.

3. Golf

- Ball retrievers will be removed from all pins and these can now be taken out.
- Rakes will be returned to bunkers, meaning the removal of 'preferred lies' in the bunkers.
- 150-yard markers will return.
- Ball washers and bins will return.
- Scoring for competitions will return to pre-covid rules, but a separate communication will be sent on this to remind you of the process.
- On course water fountains will be turned back on.

4. Booking System

A communication on the booking system will be sent out on Monday 19th July and the changes to the booking system will be in place from the 1st of August. It is being advised by England Golf to keep some form of booking system to help with track and trace. However, we will be making changes to bring a balance from the old and new system.
