

SAFETY PROTOCOL

Carrickstone 2nd and 7th Holes



All players (members and visitors) **MUST** comply with this safety protocol whilst playing either the 2nd hole or 7th hole on the Carrickstone course.

The measures detailed are intended to reduce the risk of injury to other persons, both other golf course users and users of neighbouring land and property.

Please familiarise yourself with all aspects of this protocol prior to commencing play.

As golfers, we are each personally responsible for our actions on the golf course. We must at all times give due consideration and priority to the safety of ourselves, our playing partners, other golfers, and any other persons who may be affected by our actions.

General Considerations

1. Please continue to be alert at all times to the risk of stray golf balls struck by other golfers.
2. If you hit a stray shot, you **MUST** shout **FORE** to alert other golf course users and persons on neighbouring land to the potential danger.

Specific Considerations When Playing 2nd Hole

3. Golfers playing from the 7th tee have priority over golfers playing from the 2nd tee.
4. Please ensure that 7th tee is clear before teeing off on this hole.
5. If other golfers are on the 7th tee and ready to play, you **MUST** wait until every player in that group has teed off and vacated the tee **BEFORE** you commence play from this tee.

Specific Considerations When Playing 7th Hole

6. Golfers playing from the 7th tee have priority over golfers playing from the 2nd tee.
7. On approaching the 7th tee, please ensure that there are no golfers in the process of teeing off at the 2nd hole before proceeding to the teeing area. Only continue to the teeing area if you are satisfied that it is safe to do so.
8. Please do not advance to the teeing area if the position of the group ahead of you on the 7th hole means you will need to wait for them to move forward before you can play.
9. Once you have advanced to the teeing area you will have priority over golfers arriving at or waiting to tee off from the 2nd tee. Golfers there should wait until you and your group have played your tee shots before hitting their own.
10. After all players in your group have played their tee shots, please stand well clear of the tee and wait until any golfers ready to tee off at the 2nd hole have played **BEFORE** you advance to play your next shot. Remain vigilant to the possibility of wayward shots.
