TERMS & CONDITIONS

DRESS CODE

Cancellation

The Club reserves the right to amend or cancel any reservation.

If inclement weather prevents the playing of golf, the Club will refund deposits made but will have no further liability to the Client.

Should the Client cancel they may re-book within the next calendar year and the deposit paid will be transferred. Should the booking be cancelled twice or if there is no re-booking then the deposit will usually be forfeited.

Damage to Club Property

By accepting these terms and conditions, the Client assumes responsibility for any damage to Club property caused by any member of the society.

Tee Off Times

It is the Client's responsibility to ensure that the society is ready to start play at their allocated tee times. Failure to do so may result in the society being reallocated to the next available tee times.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones must not be used while on the course, except in the case of emergencies. While in the Clubhouse lounges and Dining rooms mobile phones must be kept on silent and calls and should be made or taken elsewhere.

Dress Code

On the course

Golfing attire is required for all players. Denim, combat trousers, three quarter length cargo trousers, tracksuits, t-shirts, rugby and football shirts are not permitted on the course at any time.

All items of clothing produced specifically for golf will be seen as acceptable.

Golf shoes must be worn on the course, preferably soft or moulded spikes.

Clubhouse

Smart casual (including smart denim) is the expected dress code; on some occasions, more formal attire may be required. The following are not permitted at any time; torn denims, hats or caps, tracksuits, rugby and football shirts and beachwear must not be worn at anytime.

Golf shoes of any kind must not be worn in the Clubhouse.

Footwear must be worn at all times in the Clubhouse.

Clothing deemed unacceptable will be at the clubs discretion.
