OBTAINING YOUR HANDICAP INDEX AT HUNTSWOOD OR TRANSFERRING YOUR HANDICAP INDEX TO HUNTSWOOD

Welcome to Huntswood Golf Club

If you wish to obtain a handicap index at Huntswood you will need to have an e-mail address and "opt-in" to allow England Golf to use your e-mail address for purpose of maintaining your handicap index

If you have not already done so, this can be done by clicking on the link <u>Click Here</u>, or the link at the bottom of any Huntswood e-mail

If you do not opt-in, we will not be able to process your handicap index

Obtaining a First Handicap Index

- You will need to play a total of 54 holes which can be completed in a mixture of 9 holes (holes 1-9 only) and 18 holes (within a 6-month period)
- Counting all shots please mark the total score per hole
- An existing member with a valid WHS handicap index, no higher than 28 men/ 36 ladies must mark your card and your card must be placed in the competition box in the clubhouse when you finish your round after you have checked and signed your card
- Please submit each card individually
- When the 3rd card has been submitted, you will be allocated a handicap index
- Once you have been allocated a handicap index your name and handicap index will appear on the HowDidIDo website
- Your unique ID number and handicap index certificate is available from the Huntswood website members hub or the HowDidIDo website

Membership Number/ UID was CDH Number (Central Database of Handicaps)

- When you have a Handicap Index you will also have a personal UID (was CDH number)
- You will be able to register on the HDID App
- This number is your number; it is specific to you and your handicap index and should not be disclosed to any other player
- If you should wish to transfer your handicap index to another golf club this is the number you will need to do that.

Your handicap index certificate you will see a 10 digit number beginning 10..... this is your personal UID (was CDH number)

Transferring Your Existing Handicap Index

- If you already have a handicap index you can transfer it to Huntswood or keep it at your previous club being an "Away" member at Huntswood
- Whichever you prefer please let us know
- We will require your membership/ UID (Unique ID/ was Central Database of Handicaps) number as soon as possible after you join us so we can update your handicap information and you can enter club organised competitions
