

### **Competitions Overview**

- A COVID lockdown meant that we could not resume competitions until mid May
- Competitions played: Weekend 18-hole qualifier (25), Midweek (35, including 9-holers)
- This year we ran 9-hole qualifying competitions from 1<sup>st</sup> weekend in November until mid December - the weather was very mild which facilitated qualifying competitions and the front-9 and back-9 meant that we could accommodate more players during the reduced daylight hours
- Matchplays: We completed the 2020 fourball and singles matchplays as well as the running the 2021 singles and fourball matchplays
- WHS bedding in there were several issues with handicaps not updating correctly in ClubV1/HowDidiDo
- Seniors Competition: we started a competition for seniors, finding a sustainable model proved difficult so we will revert to a separate seniors prize in the weekend competitions
- We changed the opening time for booking competitions to Monday evening - this was intended to reduce the number of no-shows

### Survey

- 56% want to keep the mix of weekend singles, fourball and team events as is
- 78% found it easier to book a tee-time when we ran the fron-9 and back-9 competitions
- 64% prefer qualifying rather than non-qualifying (weather permitting)
- 57% would prefer 11, 12 or 13 holes rather than 9 hole competitions
- 70% prefer 13 holes rather than 11 holes on Monty
- 68% think the Monday BRS opening made no difference to No-shows
- 46% think we should stick with the Monday BRS opening, 14% think we should go back to Friday morning
- 81% want to keep the ability to book in other members in BRS



#### Key Changes for 2022

- We will look to implement Electronic Scorecards we are evaluating several options that support this
- Diary complete, balanced between Monty and O'Meara for weekends, favouring O'Meara for midweek competitions

#### Just a reminder...

- No shows / late cancellations and No Returns are too high and need to improve
- Sign in before play, complete scorecard (with handicap, signature and verifier/marker name noted), input scorecard onto app and return to bin.
- No double bookings over Saturday/Sunday competition times

- The Handicap Committee met seven times during 2021
- In the earlier part of the year, the committee worked with Golf Ireland to correct significant errors in the World Handicap System.
- These errors arose because the WHS picked up the wrong Carton course in transitioning records, The corrections had to be made manually for all members impacted by the errors.
- In the latter half of the year, the committee focused on planning and completion of the Annual Handicap Review. This review was guided by five reports generated by the Golf Ireland Clubhouse system.
- Review was completed by the end of November 2021.




## Handicaps Report 2021


