# Formal Tee booking is required at all times

Book via the on line BRS system or call Nick on 015395 35937

Turn up and play is NOT PERMITTED at this time.

# FULL Social Distance Compliance required at all times.

Members are requested to respect and comply with any of the clubs temporary adaptations in and around the club house, the Pro shop and on the course. NOTE: These may vary from day to day.

#### Arrival at the club

To avoid social gatherings members and visitors are requested to arrive no earlier than is necessary before their respective Tee time and are requested to leave as soon as possible on completion of their round.

Please respect and comply with any adaptations that may be in place on the day of arrival and follow any directional signs. Please also report to any starter in attendance.

When available course cards can be obtained from the front of the Pro shop. Recommend no exchange of cards.

### **Pro Shop**

Members are requested to observe any additional restrictions that may be in place in and around the Pro shop, respect Nick's space and comply fully with any requests he may make.

#### **USE OF FACE COVERINGS**

As from the 24th July ALL members and visitors are required to wear suitable face coverings while in the Pro shop. The club nor the pro shop have face coverings available so please ensure you bring along your own. Entry to the pro shop will not be allowed without one. NOTE: This is a Government requirement.

Wherever possible Members and Visitors are requested to use contactless card payments in order to minimise cash transactions. Cash transactions will still however be accepted.

ALL Pro shop goods and services can be pre ordered for collection.

We actively encourage members to support Nick in continuing to purchase equipment and goods from him.

#### Locker Rooms NOT IN USE AT THIS TIME

Subject to staff availability, limited access to locker rooms may be available. Access cannot be guaranteed.

When open, locker room doors will be 'wedged' open at all times. No belongings to be left in the locker rooms. If required pre arranged one off access may be possible by contacting Nick in advance.

### **Trolley Store**

The club has no way of monitoring the use of the trolley store and will not at this time be including it within any daily cleaning regime. Members are therefore advised to use there own best judgement when and if they need to access the store.

It is recommended that once a trolley has been retrieved it is then taken home and not put back in the store.

#### Club House TEMPORARILY CLOSED Only Toilets Open

The club house is currently operating a reduced service, members and visitors requiring bar and catering facilities are advised to check prior to arriving what facilities are available.

### **Practice Areas**

# **Chipping & Putting Area**

Access to the chipping and putting practice area is permitted at all times.

Members are asked to ensure full social distancing continues to be observed and to ensure there is no cross contamination of equipment or practice balls occur.

At busy times practice should be limited to a maximum of 30 minutes.

All practice balls should be clearly identifiable and should be removed once practice is finished.

### Practice Ground /Area to the side of the 9th Fairway

The practice area to the side of the 9th fairway is available to members with the following restrictions/guidelines.

There will be no restriction on number of balls permitted for practicing nor will there be a time limit to restrict practicing.

**Unless** others are waiting to use the facility. In which case members should act responsibly and restrict their practicing to approx. 30 minutes

Members and visitors should continue to use the clearly defined practice bays and ensure that social distancing is observed and maintained at all times.

Members and visitors should continue to use clearly identifiable balls at a time and ensure full retrieval of all their own practice balls before leaving the practice area.

No drivers or fairway woods to be used if other members are at the opposite end of the practice area.

#### PAYMENTS FOR GOODS AND SERVICES

Wherever possible Members and Visitors are requested to use contactless card payments in order to minimise cash transactions. Cash transactions will still however be accepted.

#### On The Course

Before commencing a round players should ensure they have read the on course guidance notes.

These are posted on the web site, on the first Tee and on request from the office.

Important NOTE There are no on course WC facilities. Members should check before commencing a round if the locker rooms are/will be open. [See separate locker room note]

# **Buggies**

Club buggies may be available but WILL require pre booking Members Buggies by prior arrangement with Nick
