



FIFE STROKEPLAY CHAMPIONSHIP
incorporating
**THE YOUTHS STROKEPLAY &
UPPER-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS**
at **Glenrothes GC**
Sunday 2nd July 2023

- 1 The Championship will be open to male amateur golfers who are members of Clubs affiliated to Fife Golfing Association, and whose handicap index does not exceed SEVEN (7.4 exact). The starting field will be limited to the 39 entrants with lowest exact handicaps.
- 2 The Championship will be decided by stroke play over 36 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Ltd. and the local rules as laid down by the Championship Committee.
- 3 The winner will be the competitor with the lowest scratch aggregate score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie, the championship will be decided by a sudden-death play off. All other prizes will be decided by the better 2nd round, or better inward half or best last 6, last 3 or last hole as may be necessary to declare a winner.
- 4 The entry fee is £30 and entries will close at 5pm on Sunday 25th June 2023.
- 5 The Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving any reason for its decision. The Committee's decision on all matters shall be final.
- 6 The General Conditions of the Competition will be published on the Fife Golfing Association website.

FIFE MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Players with the lowest 8 scratch aggregate scores will qualify to compete in the Match Play Championship.

This will be played at Glenrothes GC on 8th / 9th July 2023.

Any competitor who cannot take part in the Match Play Championship must indicate this when registering at the Fife Stroke Play Championship.

UPPER AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

The player who is aged 40 years and over on the day, and has the lowest 36 hole scratch aggregate total shall win the Upper Amateur Championship.

YOUTHS STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

The player who is aged under 21 years at 00.01 hours on 1st January 2023, and has the lowest 36 hole scratch aggregate total shall win the Youths Stroke Play Championship.

YOUTHS MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Players under 21 years of age at 00.01 hours on 1st January 2023, with the lowest 4 scratch aggregate scores, will qualify to compete in the Youths Match Play Championship at Scoonie GC. These matches will take place on evenings to be decided within two weeks of the qualifying date.

Any eligible competitor who cannot take part in the Youths Match Play Championship must indicate this when registering at the Fife Stroke Play Championship.
