Perranporth Golf Club Visitors – Safe Guide to Golf PGC PLAY SAFE STAY SAFE

We are delighted we can now welcome back visitors to the course. Thank you for booking your visit at Perranporth Golf Club. Below are the measures in place in line with the government & EGU published guidelines during Covid-19.

Access to the course, a player must:

- Not have been out of the country for over 14 days prior to the visit date
- Not be in self-isolation and not required to shield
- Not be displaying COVID-19 symptoms
- Have a pre-booked a tee time

Booking A Tee Time

- All tee times MUST be booked in advance, either on-line, through the BRS booking system or by telephone or email. There will be NO turn up and play.
- 1, 2. 3 & 4 balls are welcome.
- Tee times are at 10 minute intervals.
- Visitor tee times will commence from 10:00am daily
- The last tee times will be at 17:30.

On Arrival

- The clubhouse & facilities will be CLOSED but Reception & the Golf Shop are open on a one in, one out basis, subject to strict social distancing. Opening Hours 08:30am – 5:30pm.
- On arrival, park leaving a clear space between cars if possible.
- You should arrive golf ready or change into your shoes in your car. Locker rooms will not be available for changing.
- You should arrive no more than 10 20 minutes before your tee time. If you need to warm up with a practice putts, this will be possible, but please observe the limitation of 4 golfers (maximum) on the putting green (but pins will be removed), please maintain social distancing measures at all times.
- A Unisex toilet in the Clubhouse Reception area will be available, but accessed via designated one-way routes which will be sign-posted, and subject to strict social distancing and hand sanitation measures in-place.
- Green fee payments should either be paid in full over the phone prior to arrival or at Reception on arrival via card payment ONLY, following the strict access to Reception (one in, one out basis).
- All Golf Shop purchases we would prefer to be paid via Card Payment. Sanitise regularly and before any interaction, using the sanitiser provided.
- Maintain 2 metres social distancing at all times.

Equipment

- Only handle your own equipment (scorecard, clubs, balls, pencils and measuring devices). Do not pick up stray golf balls.
- Visitors can use their own manual or electric trolleys.
- Electric Trolley hire will not, initially, be available. Pull Trolley hire is available.
- Buggy Hire is available usage by single individuals only. These are sanitised prior to every hire.
- Bring a towel to keep golf balls clean. Ball washers are out of use.
- If playing on your own, you must only play with ONE ball.

On the Course

- You MUST maintain 2 metres social distancing at ALL times.
- Flagsticks will be in the holes but MUST NOT be touched. We provide foam lining around the bottom of the flagsticks, so that the ball stays near the surface when holed.
- There will be no bunker rakes. Please leave the bunkers as tidy as you can should you play out of them, using your club and/or shoes.
- The drinking fountains will not be in operation.
- Please ring any bells with your club, however, continue to be mindful of golfers that may be ahead of you.
- Please do not share score cards, exchange cash, shake hands or share food & drink.
- Please take all litter home with you, do not use the on course bins. Refrain from using the course benches & ball washers.
- Please be aware of using/touching these surfaces. We do not have the resources to sanitise.

After Your Round

- Do not wait for others to finish their round by congregating on the patio or in the car park.
- Please leave the golf club immediately on completion of your round.
- The benches outside the clubhouse should not be used.
- Sanitise your hands in your car and wash your hands as soon as you arrive home

Until the risk of infection recedes and government restrictions are eased further, we believe that by following the above guidelines players will have the best opportunity to safely enjoy as much golf as possible. The plan will be kept under review and revised to meet changing circumstances and guidelines.
