Hi All and apologies for my absence.

Just a quick report on behalf of myself and Dave.

Firstly, I would like to thank Steve, Ali, Andy and Sandy (sounds like a Seventies kids TV Show) for coming along to the extra meeting the other evening I thought it was great to get things moving for the coming year.

Unfortunately, we had to cancel the Ladies and the mixed open this year, due to the lack of entries, which was a great shame, however possibly the timings were not great with the kids going back to school. However, the seniors open is looking strong with 88 players at the moment with a couple of weeks to go. (I am already looking for better dates for the mixed and ladies open for 2020).

The pro-am is now set for the 18<sup>th</sup> October and is also looking strong with 17 teams already. A massive thanks once again to Mike Garner for his generous sponsorship of the event.

Due to some recent confrontations I have uploaded a code of conduct and disciplinary procedure onto the website and I hope this will any future episodes and if so mean that we can deal with them quickly. It seems that this summer there have been some niggles, and I don't really know why, but, I task the committee to be vigilant.

Dave has started his maintenance week and has been micro tining and dressing today hopefully with a little rain forecast this should heel in no time at all. He will also be starting his fungicide program to prevent disease over the winter. He has also started getting the ditch cleared ready for

the bad weather through the winter to help with drainage on the 10<sup>th</sup> fairway. Verti draining the aprons will also take place next week. We are also looking at making the field opposite the Pink lodge into a 4/5-hole pitch and putt and work will start towards October.

The survey is almost ready, and I will send it out to the membership as soon as possible although I am a little scared of the answers.

#### *Treasurer's Report*

GL Reported: - Income from competitions is once again up in relation to the previous year at this time, which is due to the increases in members playing. This currently stands at a total of £8375.00 which after provision for competition vouchers and provision for prize giving shows a nett total of £1594.57 Total expenditure for the year to date is £787.20, which shows a total nett income of £807.37 to date.

The Captains Charity account currently stands at £2055.49.

##### **Competitions Report –Sept 2019 Committee Meeting**

Firstly, my apologies for not being with you today, but I'm on holiday.

The main events during August, considering it is peak holiday season, were all well attended.

The midweek championships were won by Rob Carvill and Jan King.

The Greenkeepers revenge was well attended, and we were happy to yet again provide Dave and his team with a donation to their Christmas festivities. And in a lovely touch of irony the competition was won by Dave Knight's team.

It was good to see the club supporting Tom's Professionals Trophy. Thank you, Tom for organising this competition and donating a fantastic prize table. The winners were Connor Jeanes and Sue Foote.

There were some no shows at the Greenkeepers Revenge, which detrimentally affected the other members of the teams they were playing in.

I have passed details of contact made with the no shows to the club president and he will share this with you. We have given them an opportunity to explain their absence before taking action.

I have spoken to Tom regarding this we are proposing the process for no shows should be

- Call the person as soon as possible (if quiet, the pro shop could call during the competition). This call is a courtesy to give them a chance to explain, and to let them know the committee will be reviewing their non-attendance.
- The details, and explanation will be brought to the next committee meeting and the committee will agree the appropriate course of action.

We feel that this approach, rather than the very black and white process of fining as stated in the comp manual would be a better process in terms of keeping communications going with the club members and not causing unnecessary aggravation with them.

I hope the committee agree with this approach. If so I will update the competitions manual accordingly.

Tom and I have also agreed a slight change to the process leading up to competitions in order to minimise the number of no shows.

- On the Wednesday before the comp send out a preliminary start sheet / entry list to those who have entered, reminding them that they have entered the competition and remind

them that if they are not going to show up to withdraw before Friday midday, after which they will be liable to pay the entry fee.
