Well done to all the ladies who supported this winter's competition, with all qualifying rounds played in very difficult weather.

The arrival of Storm Jorge also caused the cancellation of Saturday's competition, and all members will be hoping that spring heralds something significantly better than the wettest autumn and winter on record.
