Full Membership: Cost £660 per year

Membership includes:

Access to the course seven days a week.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to all competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

6 Day Membership: Cost £567 per year

Membership includes:

Access to the course six days a week - Sunday through Friday.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to Sunday and Week day competitions only.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting,

Week Day Membership (4.5-days): Cost £534 per year. (CLOSED TO NEW ENTRANTS)

Membership includes:

Access to the course five days a week - Monday through Friday.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to Week day competitions - Monday through Friday.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

18 - 21 (incl.) Membership: Cost - £153

Membership includes:

Access to the course seven days a week.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to all competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests to play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card. Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Term and conditions - Must be within the age range 18 - 21 years of age, at the start of the golf year.

Students of existing playing members in and remaining in full-time education will be allowed to be members of this category free of charge. As Students they will not be allowed to win any of the Club's "Major Competitions" as Students.

Lower intermediate membership (22-26): Cost - £220per year.

Membership includes:

Access to the course seven days a week.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to all competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Term and conditions - Must be under age 27 years, at the start of the golf year on 1 April to qualify for this category.

Upper intermediate membership (27-34): Cost - £440 per year

Membership includes:

Access to the course seven days a week.

[Ladies have priority on Wednesday mornings]

Access to all competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests to play the course with them at reduced rates.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Terms and conditions - Must be under 35 at the start of the golf year.

Family Membership: Cost £855 per year. - (CLOSED TO NEW ENTRANTS)

To qualify for this category of membership a family is defined here as 2 financially connected adults plus Child/children who are financially dependent. The children must be under age 18 at the start of the golf year.

Membership includes:

First adult receives full seven day membership.

Second adult receives 6 day membership Sunday through Friday for spouse / partner.

Membership for children up to the age of 18 years into the category relevant to their age at the start of the golf year (see "Junior Membership Categories below).

Access to all competitions relevant to each membership category.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Adults are entitled to Bar Discount cards.

Family Discount Scheme

Married couples (or co-habiting "long-term" financially dependent partners who are both 6 or 7 day members, will be entitled to a further 5% discount on **each** of their annual fees. Any Bar Credits or similar bonus discounts are unaffected. In addition any children or grandchildren under age 18 at the 1st April, will be entitled to play as members free of charge. This concession will be further extended to Students in fulltime further education up to age 21 or until they cease to be full-time education, if before. In the event of any dispute the Membership Secretary's decision is final.

Sunday Membership: Cost £210 per year.

Membership includes:

Access to the course on Sundays only.

Access to Sunday competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Academy Membership - Cost £123 per year.

Membership includes:

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Bar discount card.

Access to the golf course paying reduced rate green fees each time you play.

You can only play Sunday to Friday excluding Wednesday mornings.

You must pay your green fee before playing.

You do not receive a WHS Handicap from the Club

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Corporate membership: Cost TBA (Tailored Packages).

Access to the course seven days a week for one nominated person/s.

Access to all competitions for one nominated person/s.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

These are individually tailored packages are available on request/by consultation.

Community Membership: Cost £499.

Access to the course seven days a week.

Access to all competitions.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Members can bring guests who the play the course at reduced rates.

Bar discount card.

Eligible to attend and to vote at a general meeting.

Terms and conditions apply for eligibility for this membership category.

Applicants must be in receipt Income Support Allowances. Further details on a confidential basis are available from the membership Secretary.

Country Membership - cost £186.

This membership category requires that individuals must hold a membership at a recognised golf club, and who does not reside within a 30 mile radius of the Glossop Golf Club facility. Similarly a member of the club who resigns because of removal away from the district may apply for country membership. Course availability equivalent to a 6-Day membership.

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Bar discount card.

Trial membership: cost £130 for 3 months of golf.

Access to the course 5.5 days per week [excludes all day Saturday and Wednesday mornings].

Access to short game / practice facilities.

Bar discount card.

Access to Sunday and Tuesday competitions, at a reduced green fee rate. Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities. This is one-off opportunity and a person cannot have two periods as a "Trialist". Only open to players who have not been a member of Glossop G C in the last 3 years.

Junior Academy Membership - Cost £25 per year.

(Free for children or grandchildren of a 5,6,7 day members)

This membership category is for young people at entry level who are not considered sufficiently proficient to play on the course. Membership includes unlimited access to short game / practice facilities with appropriate levels of supervision. Parents and Guardians of members of this category are eligible for free Social Membership.

Junior Membership up to age 12(inclusive): Cost £10 per year.

Membership includes:

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Access to the course 5.5 days per week, excludes all day Saturday and Wednesday mornings.

[If 13 before the start of the golf year then 13-18 category applies.] Parents/Guardians are expected to supervise their children when at the Club.

Access to Junior Competitions.

Junior Membership up to age 13-17 (inclusive): Cost £78 per year

Membership includes:

Unlimited access to short game / practice facilities.

Access to the course 5.5 days per week [excludes Saturday and Wednesday mornings].

Access to all junior competitions.

Access to senior competitions subject to the payment of the relevant competition fees.

Children or Grandchildren of existing playing members (who are 5,6, and 7-day members) will be allowed to be members of this category free of charge. They will not be allowed to enter Saturday Competitions.

Social Membership: Cost £30 per year.

Membership Includes.

Bar discount card.

Access to social events

Friends of Glossop Golf Club

Certain approved group members are entitled to become Social Member Visitors of the Club for £10.

Important Rules in relation to Club Membership and Visitors

- 1) The "Golf Year" commences on 1st April each year.
- 2) Whenever a green fee is payable, whether by a MEMBER or a VISITOR, that fee (and the accompanying paperwork) MUST BE completed by the Professional or Steward before commencing play on the course. The only permissible exception is when booking and payment has been made on-line through BRS.
- 3) A VISITOR can only be signed in the Visitor's Book (on the reduced rate basis) up to a MAXIMUM of 5 times in any one calendar year. Full Green Fee is payable thereafter.
- 4) Members whose category of membership allows them to sign in visitors, are only allowed to do so if they are accompanying those visitors on the course, and only after they have fully completed the Visitor's Book and paid the green-fee.
- 5) Certain categories allow that member to **pay and play** at a "Reduced green fee" is that defined as the "**with a member fee**" i.e. the reduced rate applicable to a member signing in a visitor.
- 6) If a member is unable to play golf **for a long period through sustained injury or serious ill health,** they may be entitled to a discounted rate for membership in the year when recommencing playing. The discounted rate to be decided by the Membership Secretary solely, and will take into account the time of year of the absence.
- 7) If a member has restricted days playing rights but wishes to play outside their allocated entitlement, they must pay a reduced green fee (see 5 above)
- 8) **All Members** are able to hire the Club House for their own personal functions at a discounted rate (currently of £25), subject to availability.
- 9) From time to time **the course may be closed due to Weather**, repair work or because of competitions. Refunds or partial refunds cannot be paid to members under such circumstances.
- 10) All previous concessions granted to members in respect of playing rights **e.g. free 4-ball for 7-day members**, are replaced in full by these rules.
