Shotts Golf Club Deputy Head Greenkeeper

Shotts Golf Club are currently looking for a deputy head greenkeeper to join they're greens team. Shotts is a James Braid designed part heathland part parkland 18 hole golf course established in 1895. The course is based 25 minutes from both Glasgow and Edinburgh.

Job Purpose

To assist the course manager in all aspects of his role and to carry out routine golf course maintenance tasks as directed by the Head Green keeper, in accordance with the Club's Health and Safety Policy on the 18 hole course.

Key responsibilities and accountabilities under direction from the Course Manager

- Cut tees, greens, surrounds, fairways, rough and semi rough
- Set up the golf course, including changing holes, moving tee markers, indicating OOB, Drop zones and hazards
- Switch and brush greens
- Apply top dressing and fertilizer
- Prepare and maintain machinery where applicable.
- Identify and control pests and diseases
- Renovate worn and damaged turf
- Monitor and Maintain health, safety and security in the workplace for self and others
- Driving a tractor with implements
- Preparing machinery for use
- Preparing machinery for storage
- To complete work in any section that The Company may require you to, carrying out other duties within your capabilities, as the workload so requires.
