

LOCAL RULES - HAWKSTONE COURSE

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

- (a) Beyond any fence, hedge, wall or line of white stakes bounding the course.
- (b) On or over the car park and surrounds of and including the Hotel and Golf Centre defined by white posts.

INTERNAL OUT OF BOUNDS

- (a) Beyond the line of white stakes to the left of the 8th hole when playing the 8th.
- (b) Beyond the line of white stakes to the right of the 18th hole when playing the 18th.

2. PENALTY AREAS – are defined by Red Stakes and/or Red Lines (Rule 17)

DROPPING ZONE

If a ball is in the penalty area at the rear and left of the 13th green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player may:

- Take stroke and distance relief under Rule 17.1d(1) adding one penalty stroke
- or
- Drop the original ball or another ball in the designated dropping zone adding one penalty stroke. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3

3. PROTECTION FROM YOUNG TREES

The young trees identified by being attached to a stake/protective band are NO PLAY zones.

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (Rule 16)

- Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line and/or GUR signs. It also includes:-
- Areas in bunkers where sand has been removed by the movement of water resulting in deep furrows through the sand are ground under repair.
- When bunkers are flooded bunkers become ground under repair.
- All alternative greens when not in use.

The following are classed as Abnormal Course Conditions/Immovable Obstructions and relief without penalty is provided in accordance with Rule 16.1:

- (a) All paths and roadways and distance markers (where embedded within the fairway)
- (b) Drainage covers and sprinkler heads.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

General Penalty – 1.e.
Match Play - Loss of Hole
Stroke Play - Two Strokes
