



#### **General**

- 1.0 The Clubhouse is open from 07.30 hours when coffee and breakfast, if ordered beforehand, will be available from the Restaurant.
- 1.1 Ride-On buggies are permitted for use by authorised users. Please contact the Pro Shop for further details.
- 1.2 Please settle payments in respect of Green Fees, Bar and Catering Bills prior to departure.
- 1.3 Cancellations within 14 days will result in the loss of the £100 deposit.
- 1.4 There may be limitations as to the use of the Main Lounge. These will be controlled by the Secretary or Bar Manager.
- 1.5 Should entertainment be required for your day, please inform the Office for assistance.
- 1.6 Please ensure ALL members of your party have had sight of the up-to-date dress code to avoid any embarrassment (included in this document)

#### **Handicaps**

2.0 Please ensure all players in your Society hold a Club or Society Handicap.

#### **General Play**

- 3.0 Play will be from the yellow and red tees.
- 3.1 Normal rules of golf and etiquette should be observed. Please ensure Trolleys and Buggies are not taken over Greens and onto Tees.

#### **Practice**

4.0 Practising is permitted on the practice ground, the chipping area and the putting green. Please do not practice chipping to the Putting Green.

#### Catering

- 5.0 Catering requirements and numbers should be confirmed with the office 2 weeks prior to your day when the final invoice will be raised.
- 5.1 Please inform the office of any dietary requirements at least 2 weeks before arrival.

  Unfortunately, alterations to catering cannot be made on the day and any additional requirements will be charged for.
- 5.2 When making catering choices, please choose 1 option for your entire group, informing us of any dietary requirements at the same time.

## Mid Kent Golf Club Dress and Club House Regulations

(Revised March 2020)

Please ensure that all members of your Society are aware of the Dress Code to avoid any embarrassment

Mid Kent is a modern golf club and we consider that appropriate behaviour both in the club house and on the golf course, is far more important than dictating how an individual should be dressed.

#### Clubhouse

As a guideline for our members and visitors to our club, please note that any clean smart casual clothing, including denim (not distressed or ripped), is acceptable in the clubhouse, although we do ask that hats & caps are removed and gentlemen wear collared or golfing shirts that may be untucked.

We also request golfers to change from their playing attire during wet weather conditions to prevent mud being brought into the clubhouse. Any workwear should also be clean, smart and dirt free.

Spiked shoes or flip flops are not permitted in the bar areas, but clean trainers and modern pimpled golf shoes are perfectly acceptable. Golf shoes in the clubhouse are only acceptable during dry weather.

Please ensure mobile phones are switched to silent or vibrate mode and are only used in the foyer area, outside the front or rear of the clubhouse and for emergencies only on the course.

#### Golf course

On the golf course we accept fashion changes very quickly and our current guideline is simply that any recognised golfing apparel that can be purchased from a professional golf retail outlet is acceptable.

Gentlemen's shirts these days are designed to be worn in or outside the waistband and socks of any variety are fine.

Golf shorts should be tailored, and cargo shorts are, as yet, not deemed "golfing apparel".
