## Courtesy Reciprocal Agreement

Purpose: To provide members at Welwyn Garden City and Droitwich with an alternative course to play on an occasional basis, without additional charge, to add value to their membership and continue the close association we have between our clubs.

- Members must speak to a member of staff in their own Club's office or Pro Shop in order that they can phone the respective club's Pro Shop. In all cases, bookings will be subject to availability. Details of players' names must be communicated to the Club.
- 2. Applications for group bookings in excess of 8 players would be considered on individual merit.
- 3. On arrival at the club the players should report to the Pro Shop and sign in before playing.
- 4. The scheme will operate Monday to Friday subject to availability. In order to provide a benefit to those Full Members who can only play at weekends, the scheme will also operate on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays after 12 noon. Courtesy will also apply if a member is playing with a member of the "home" club on a Saturday or Bank Holiday morning. This must also be communicated in advance. Courtesy will not be available on a Sunday morning.
- 5. No attempt should be made to introduce people who are not members of the two clubs without payment of the appropriate green fee.
- 6. As both Clubs offer discount at the bar, this benefit will be extended to members of both clubs when visiting the other club at the prevailing rate (currently 20% at WGC and 12.5% at Droitwich).
- 7. This agreement does not include Courtesy for members of each club visiting the other as part of a society.
