Members Code of Conduct HGC.05.C04

1.0 Purpose

The intention of this policy is to establish clear and acceptable behaviour expectations for the Honiton Golf Club Ltd members and guests. It is not intended to restrict the rights of anyone but rather to ensure that all members and guests are treated with respect while enjoying the HGC golf course, practice facilities and Clubhouse.

The Club deems that upon payment of membership or guest fees, all members and guests have given their consent to be bound by this code of conduct.

2.0 Objectives

- Respect the rights of all other members, staff, management and Directors
- Not engage in any form of sexual, racial, religious or other harassment
- Respect the golf course and facilities
- Abide by all local, provincial and national laws and regulations
- Adhere to the dress code and observe proper golf etiquette at all times.

4.0 Members of HGC Ltd

- Members should ensure that confidential material provided to them or discussed within a meeting of the Club or Committee remain confidential and within the confines of the meeting and must not be discussed outside of the Club.
- When using social media / e mails in connection with the club, its officials or members, do so in a manner which could not be deemed offensive.
- Members who are unhappy or wish to put forward a recommendation regarding the service /work of an employee must address this to the Manager or a Director of the Club.
