## CALCULATING COUNTBACKS IN COMPETITIONS

Should a tie result in either a strokeplay or stableford competition the winner(s) and subsequent placings will be decided on countback of score or points.

For a scratch competition (i.e. no handicaps) the gross scores should be used. For a handicap competition (i.e. with handicaps) the net scores should be used.

For stableford competition the stableford points should be used.

The countback is calculated as follows:

1	The last 9 holes of the course
2	The last 6 holes of the course
3	The last 3 holes of the course
4	The last hole of the course
5	The last 2 holes of the course
6	The last 4 holes of the course
7	The last 5 holes of the course
8	The last 7 holes of the course
9	The last 8 holes of the course
10	The last 10 holes of the course
11	The last 11 holes of the course
12	The last 12 holes of the course
13	The last 13 holes of the course
14	The last 14 holes of the course
15	The last 15 holes of the course
16	The last 16 holes of the course
17	The last 17 holes of the course
18	By lot

Countback is always made in the way described above regardless of which hole the players started from.

### Peculiarities and Ties:-

Shield presented in 1962 by Mrs P H Barton (Florrie) and Mrs E (Dot) Smith  
Two Annual Matches - Harwich & Dovercourt Ladies to be played each year: one in the spring and one in summer, with the same numbers playing in each match. One home and one away, to alternate home and away each year.

18 Hole 4BBB Matchplay WHS rules apply to calculate players course handicap. To calculate the shots allowed, take Player's handicap index and calculate their course handicap using the WHS Course Handicap Tables. Shots received are taken from the lowest player and then 90% is deducted from the difference. See example below.

A player has a Handicap Index of 24.9 = Course Handicap 29. The lowest player has a course handicap of 20 so the difference is 9 shots. 90% of 9 = 8.1 rounded down to 8 shots allowed.

Both Clubs will endeavour to match each other's number of players. If in the return match a team is short, then a game has to be given to the Club with a full team  
The aggregate score of the two matches will decide the winner. If the score is halved, then each Club will hold the shield for six months. The winner of the Trophy pays for the engraving.

The Captains and Vice Captains are to lead the field wherever possible and thereafter the teams will play in handicap order starting with the lowest handicap.  
Where possible the dates and tee times for the following year are to be made after the last match (To be confirmed). The organiser for the year will be decided by the current Lady Captain.

All 18-hole, individual handicap qualifying, club competitions played throughout the year will determine the club winner who qualifies to enter for a place in an Area Final.

### Peculiarities:-

There will be 10 area finals held nationwide from May to July (see website for area final information - [The-race-to-woodhall-spa - England Golf](#)) with each field consisting of 60 male and 60 female players. Once the winner has been identified, the club will be able to enter their male and female player before the closing date deadline. The Club will pay the entry fees.

Players who qualify from their club can select which one of the 10 venues across the country they would like to enter. If a chosen Area Final is over-subscribed, players may be offered either a place on the reserve list or a place at an alternative venue where possible. Up to 6 females and 6 males will qualify from each Area Final to the Grand Final – see website for details of the Grand Final which changes each year.

Online entry will usually open in November and close in March (check The Road to Woodall Spa website - [The-race-to-woodhall-spa - England Golf](#) – for exact details each year. If either club winner is not available for an Area Final, a 'next best placed' substitute from the club is allowed.
