


Head Greenkeeper, Sandy Young and his team, have initiated the first steps of the project by laying the foundations for the range and the new first tee. Despite the inclement weather our goal, having the driving range completed by 1st April 2020, remains achievable. The Driving Range will be at zero cost to the club. However, if the work is not completed, then the £6K grant would have to be returned – it cannot be used for anything else.

It is hoped that members and non-members alike will take full advantage of the excellent warm up, practice and coaching facilities that will be available. Initially baskets of balls will be available from the pro-shop before installation of an automatic dispenser later next year.

## Medals 2020 season (Gents)

Prior to the introduction of the new handicap and sloping rating being introduced in November 2020 where each set of tees will have a slope rating allowing scores from any set of tees to count for handicap purposes we are proposing to have 3 divisions in medals and stablefords for the month of April and May with a view to continue with this set up for the rest of the season. Each entrant will be able to choose the tees they wish to play from WHITE SSS 71,YELLOW SSS 69 or RED SSS 67 (SGU still to ratify) we hope this introduction of choice will help members to enjoy competitive golf and to maintain their handicap yearly.

#### Rules of Golf – Preferred Lies

- You are only entitled to Prefer Your Lie ONCE!
- Once you have 'Marked' (yes, you have to do this), 'Lifted', 'Cleaned' and 'Replaced' your ball, not nearer the hole, within 6 inches (about the width of a score card) the Ball is now IN PLAY
  - o If you cause it to move or lift it again because you don't like that Lie, after all, you are in breach of the Rules and will incur a Penalty.
- Also, if you are required to take a Penalty Drop (from Knee Height) for whatever reason you cannot skip this part just because Preferred Lies are in operation and you will be able to place it eventually anyway. You must make the drop first, then follow the 'Preferred Lie' procedure second.
  - o Preferred Lies for Haddington are allowed if a player's ball lies in a part of the *general area* (*i*) cut to fairway height or less or (ii) in the first cut of rough


## **General Area**

The area of the course that covers all of the course except for the other four defined areas: (1) the *teeing area* the player must play from in starting the hole he or she is playing, (2) all *penalty areas*, (3) all *bunkers*, and (4) the *putting green* of the hole the player is playing.

The general area includes:

- ❖ All teeing locations on the course other than the teeing area, and
- ❖ All wrong greens.
