



ETIQUETTE

In consideration for other players please observe the following:

- Repair pitchmarks on greens
- Replace divots on fairways
- Rake bunkers when you have played out of them
- Play without undue delay
- Do not play until the players in front are out of range
- If you lose a hole on the group in front you must invite the group following to play through
- Greens staff have priority on the course at all times
- Courtesy of the course to be extended to the Captain and Lady Captain

DRESS CODE

On the course:

- Smart dress appropriate to golf is expected
- Golf shoes to be worn
- Shirts must have a collar and sleeves. Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts
- Denim and tracksuits are not permitted
- Beach, football or other sports shorts are not permitted

In The Clubhouse:

- Smart casual dress
- There may be specific dress requirements for some club functions

COURSE RULES

Course Closure

- The decision as to whether the course should be closed will be made by the greens staff by 8.00am weekdays and 7.30am weekends (as long as daylight hours allow).
- If there has been excessive rain or other adverse conditions please do not tee off until the decision has been made.
- Information regarding course conditions and closure can be found as follows:

All are updated as soon as a decision has been made
- The greens staff's decision is final on whether the course should be closed or a limited number of holes can be played on any day.

Thunder and Lightening

- When there is lightening players should suspend play immediately and seek shelter in an appropriate place i.e. a shelter on the course or the clubhouse (depending which is closer). It is not necessary to wait to hear the siren.

- If you are in a competition and have not completed the hole please mark where your ball has landed.
- One blast of the siren from the pro shop will signal that the course is closed, play is suspended and the above action should be taken.
- Play can resume when the siren is sounded for a second time.

Rain

- If there is excess rain that causes the course to close the Pro shop will sound one blast of the siren.
- Players must suspend play with immediate affect and players should make their way back to the clubhouse.
- Please try and inform players behind and in front of you if it is possible to do so if they have not heard the siren.
- If you are in a competition and have not completed the hole please mark where your ball has landed.
- Staff will inform you whether play will be resumed or the course closed for the remainder of the day.

Fog

- When there are foggy conditions players must not tee off unless they can see the left hand bunker on the 1st fairway from the men's yellow tee.
- If the bunker cannot be seen play will be suspended until it is clearly visible.
- If players have teed off and play has to be suspended due to fog Pro shop staff will sound the siren.
- Players must suspend play with immediate affect.
- If you are in a competition and have not completed the hole please mark where your ball has landed.
- Please try and inform players behind and in front of you if it is possible to do so if they have not heard the siren.
- Play can resume when the siren is sounded for a second time.

Frost

- Players should be aware that when conditions are frosty that steps, bridges, paths and other areas of the course may be slippery.
- Caution should be taken at all times.

Trolleys and Buggies

- Trolleys and buggies should not be taken close to greens, over tees or between greens and greenside bunkers.
- At times of the year when white lines or directional signs are put on the course trolleys and buggies must not be taken past these lines or signs so that the front of greens and other areas are protected.
