<u>Clonmel Clubhouse reopens on Friday December 4th subject to the following conditions:</u>

"Restaurants and pubs operating as restaurants (serving a substantial meal) can open for indoor dining with additional restrictions, including a requirement for meals to be prepared on site, inside the premises, with a maximum of 6 people per table".

- Parties or functions are not permitted under the current restriction
- Members may book a meal for a party of not more than 6 people.

Bar and Restaurant

Firstly I would like to welcome back Martin Kane and his staff after further period of enforced closure and I would encourage our members to support him now that our bar and catering service is resuming.

As the bar/restaurant service provider, Martin is the designated COVID-19 Response Team/Coordinator and is responsible for ensuring that the Covid 19 restrictions are complied with in the Bar and Restaurant area. Please respect his position and cooperate with him in the exercise of this function.

- Observe the signage and floor markings in place in the area
- Occupancy of the bar/restaurant area is limited to not more than 45 people seated.
- Customers must be seated
- Maintain at least 1 metre social distance while in the bar/restaurant.
- Maintain designated distance between customer and bar counter when placing and collecting your order.
- Do not stay more than 1 hour. 45 minutes in the bar/restaurant
- Use cashless transactions where possible
- Use hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the area

Serving Alcohol in the bar/restaurant

The following is the Government guideline in relation to serving alcohol:

"For the purpose of opening in Phase 3, pubs should be required to serve a substantial meal under the definition currently in the Intoxicating Liquor Act 1962, as well as meeting other features expected of a restaurant". The minimum value of a substantial meal is set at €9.

To comply with the above, members who would like to have a drink in the clubhouse will need to purchase a substantial meal. Martin has arranged a number of suitable menus in the designated price range. **Please pre-order your meal where possible.**

Members who do not wish to purchase a meal will of course be free to purchase the usual range of non-alcoholic beverages and snacks without pre-ordering.

Covid symptoms

The first rule is that if you are feeling unwell or have any of the Covid 19 symptoms you should stay away from the golf club and follow the HSE guidelines to look after your health.

Signage

Signage will be displayed throughout the building detailing the guidelines to be followed in each area. Please read the signage and familiarise yourself with the guidelines.

Men's Locker room and Showers.

Occupancy of the Men's locker room will be limited to 6 people at any one time. The shower room will be limited to 2 people at a time.

Social distancing of 2 metres should be practised and hand sanitiser should be used on entering and leaving the locker room. Sanitiser will be available but it would be good practice for members to bring their own.

Toilets

Occupancy of the Men's and Ladies toilets will be limited to 3 people at a time. Use hand sanitisation before and after visiting the toilet. Wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds after using the toilet. Members are expected to clean the toilet after use and leave it as they would expect to find it.

Contact Tracing

Contact tracing will be implemented by use of the BRS printout. Martin or his designate will check off the names of members using the bar/restaurant on the printout and keep the record on file. He will maintain a separate record of people using the facility whose names are not on the BRS.

We are fully aware of the restrictive nature of the above guidelines but we ask you to comply with them as they are in line with the best expert advice designed to keep us safe from contact with the Covid 19 virus.
