#### Clean your golf clubs!

Give your golf clubs a good spring clean and check, especially if you didn't do it after your final pre-lockdown round. Pay particular to the grooves and grips – if both are those aren't clean and up to scratch, there's every chance your comeback round won't be either. You'll be amazed just how



much of a difference dirty grooves can make and the last thing you want is your driver slipping out of your hands as you hit your opening shot!

#### Warm-up for your round!

Yes, we've all made a mad dash for the first tee and hit our opening driver without so much as a stretch, but this is not the time to do it.

Unless you've been lucky enough to have a decent home practice set-up or simulator then you won't have swung a club properly in months and, regardless what some people may say, golf is an athletic sport for which the body needs to be prepared. Try to go hell for leather off the first tee without getting your muscles warm and you could find yourself missing another few months of golf with an injury.

If you have time then head to the range and work your way through a proper routine, moving through your clubs gradually, focusing on getting loose and stretching your body ready for the round. Not only will it ensure you're warm enough for that first tee shot, it'll prove less daunting knowing you've hit some on the range beforehand.

If you don't have time for such a thorough warm up then at least be sure to stretch properly!

#### Your course needs your attention:-

"We are only in our first few weeks of opening and the pitch marks on the greens are plentiful. Please help by at least repairing your own firstly and then one other!!

Also, as we are not yet allowed to put rakes in the bunkers, placing within six inches (not nearer the hole) as recommended by England Golf will continue. It would be appreciated by those following you on the course, if you smoothed the bunker with a club or your foot **after** playing out, again in line with England Golf rules.

# Casual Round Score input on the My EG app



Through our 'My EG' mobile app, available on Apple and Android devices, you can now preregister then submit a casual round score for handicap purposes from either a 9-hole or 18hole round played in accordance with the Rules of Handicapping.

- Geo-location will ensure you can only pre-register and post a round within a close proximity to the course.
- A time lag will ensure a user has to spend a reasonable amount of time before submitting a score.
- All scores must be verified by a playing partner who also holds a WHS index and has witnessed the round.

## Troubleshooting

Struggling to see the 'Enter Score' function on your app? Try the following steps to ensure you have the latest version:

- 1. Visit the App Store on your phone and download the latest version of the My EG app.
- 2. Sign out of your My EG app, then sign back in.
- 3. Go to 'settings' on your mobile device, and search for App Store. Within this section, check your preferences are set to automatic updates switched on (this is a green background for Apple users).
- 4. Under settings and App Store, make sure your automatic downloads are switched on (again, so the switch has a green background for Apple users).
- 5. Uninstall the app from your phone, then go to the App Store and reinstall it.

England Golf also wish to reiterate:

We've received a number of enquiries about rules around buggies. Based on **<u>government</u>** <u>**regulations**</u>, our current guidance on social distancing is that two members of the same household or social bubble may share buggies (including club or privately owned buggies).

Otherwise, they should be used by **individuals only** as it is impossible to share a buggy and maintain appropriate social distance. Facilities should follow sensible precautions and clean equipment after every use.

We need to remember that even as the restrictions continue to ease, the basic principles of the guidance should continue to be followed: hands, face, space. Our <u>Play Safe, Stay Safe</u> <u>Framework</u> is always available to help provide support and guidance.

ENGLAND GOLF – APRIL 2021

The golf club rule for use of buggies in competitions is:

The use of buggies is not allowed in Club competitions, unless the player is covered by the Disability Act or has a medical exemption, in both cases the person must seek prior permission from the Chair of Matches and Competitions. All requests will be in confidence and dealt with sympathetically.

Please therefore make sure that you have emailed Nigel Chesters (Chair of M & C) and received approval. Permission needs to be granted for each calendar year.
